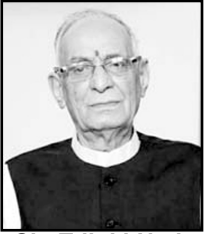

Man arrested for committing unnatural sex with boy

BUDGAM: Police on Sunday arrested a man for committing an unnatural sexual offence upon a minor boy in Chadoora area of Budgam.

As per the details, On December 24, 2022, Police Station Chadoora received a written complaint from parents of a minor boy (aged about 15yrs) stating there in that their son has been kidnapped by a 60-year-old man Mohammad Sidiq Sheikh son of Ali Mohammad Sheikh resident of Gogji Pathri Chadoora and had taken to Jammu where he committed an unnatural sexual offence upon him.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 205/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Chadoora and investigation was initiated.

During the course of the investigation, the medical examination of the victim was done and later he was shifted to Child Protection Unit Budgam.

Today, the accused was arrested from Railway Station Budgam and has been booked under POCSO Act, besides other sections of law. Further investigation into the matter is going on.



Four bootleggers nabbed, 154 bottles of liquor seized

UDHAMPUR/ KISHTWAR: Police on Sunday nabbed four bootleggers and recovered 154 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

As per the details, a surprise Naka was established at University road Manthala area for checking of vehicles by a team of Police Post Tikri headed by PSI Abdul Satar under the supervision of Addl. SP Udhampur Anwar Ul Haq and Sahil Mahajan DySP Hqrs Udhampur: During checking of vehicles and pedestrian, police stopped one scooty (JK20B 2356) for checking. On frisking of the rider of said scooty, 40 quarters of JK Special Whisky were recovered from his possession. On enquiry the scooty rider disclosed his name as Rampal, son of Rattan Chand, resident of Kakrayal Tehsil Katra of District Reasi who was arrested on spot and 40 quarters of illicit liquor were also seized. FIR No. 321/2022 under sections 48(A) Excise Act was registered against him in Police Station Rehambal.

In another instance, a special Naka was established old wine shop bus stand by SHO Police Station Kishtwar Insp Abid Bukhari accompanied by PSI Vikram Kotach under the supervision of Dy:SP Zia-Ul-Haq. During frisking of vehicles and pedestrian, police party noticed suspicious moment of two pedestrian and accordingly they were intercepted and during their search 111 bottles of liquor were recovered from their luggage and subsequently arrested on spot. The arrested persons have been identified as Naveen Kumar, son of Bhagat Ram, resident of Fagmar Sarthal and Farooq Ahmed, son of Gh Rasool, resident of Marwah at present Sangrambatta Kishtwar. FIR No. 309/2022 Under Sections 48 (A), Excise Act was registered against them at Police Station Kishtwar.

Youth narrowly escapes of bullet shot during practice firing

REASI: A youth narrowly escaped being shot in Vijaypur village adjacent to Reasi district headquarters. It is being told that this bullet was fired during the exercise of recruits from Talwara Police Special Training Center; about one kilometer from there. However, the police inspected the spot after stopping the exercise.

About half an hour before the incident, the local villagers told that during the practice at the training center, many times the bullets reach Vijaypur village. In the afternoon, 20-year-old Rohit, son of Ramesh Kumar, a local resident, had to go to the bathroom of the house. As soon as he went inside the bathroom and was locking the door, a bullet hit the door. In incident, Rohit has a narrow escape. On getting information, Reasi police reached the spot after immediately stopping the firing practice.

Accused fled from police custody; raids on, cop attached

BARI BRAHMANA: Teams have been deployed to trace the prisoner who escaped from Bari Brahmana police station. In this case, the sentry of the gate outside the police station attacked in district police line.

According to the information, Rishay Ahmed, an accused who was lodged in the Police Station, escaped on Saturday by dodging the police. The prisoner complained of pain in the stomach. As soon as he was taken out of the lockup, he attacked the police officer and ran away. After his escape, the policeman was rushed to the hospital for treatment in an injured condition. The search for the accused prisoner was started. A case has also been registered and Shashii Kumar, the sentry posted on duty has been attached in District Police Lines.

Youth dies under suspicious circumstances

According to information, Pratham Gill, son of Ravi Gill resident of Christian Colony was found lying unconscious in Phllain Mandal area in suspicious condition. He taken to the hospital but during investigation the doctors declared him brought dead. Police took his body into custody and registered a case in this context.

Man beaten up in bar; money, gold chain snatched

According to the information, a person had gone to a bar located in Bahu Plaza on Saturday night. Acting on his complaint, the police registered a case in this context. During investigation, it was found that he had come to the bar on a routine basis and was assaulted by staff and bouncers over an issue. He told that his gold chain and Rs 45 thousand have been snatched. Police has registered an a case and arrested two accused.

Man arrested for aerial firing

Man arrested for snatching money from youth

2 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substance recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Sunday arrested 02 drug peddlers and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

As per the details, a party of Police Station Khansahib at a checkpoint established at Wagar Khansahib intercepted a vehicle (Alto-800) bearing registration number JK04B-0592 with two persons onboard. They have been identified as Riyaz Ahmad Dar son of Wali Mohd resident of Khari Bagh Gopal Saif Chadoora and Mohd Altaf Rather son of Mohd Akbar resident of Chill Panzan Chadoora.

During search, 100 grams of Charas covered in maize-cob leaves was recovered from their possession. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 205/2022 under relevant sections of law has been registered at Police Station Khansahib and investigation has been initiated.



3 vehicle lifters arrested; stolen vehicle recovered within 24 hours

BUDGAM: Police on Sunday solved a vehicle lifting case by arresting three persons and recovered stolen vehicle from their possession.

As per the details, on December On 24, 2022, Police Post Soibugh received a written complaint from Javaid Ahmad Shiekh Son in law of Ghulam Nabi Sheikh resident of Churpora to the effect that during intervening night of 22/23 December his vehicle (Tavera) bearing registration number JK01P-2371 parked along road side at Churpora Aarath has been stolen by some unknown thieves.

Consequently, a case vide FIR No. 410/2022 under relevant section of law was registered at Police Station Budgam and investigation was initiated.

During the course of investigation, after working on various leads and strenuous efforts, the stolen vehicle was recovered from Parimpora Barthana area of Srinagar within 24 hours and one accused person involved in vehicle theft case was arrested who was identified as Lateef Pathan son of Ali Pathan resident of Mujipathri Khansahib.

During sustained questioning, the accused disclosed names of his two more accomplices identified as Parvaiz Ahmed Sheikh son of Ab Ahad Sheikh resident of Kechama Baramulla & Altaf Ahmed Sheikh son of Ab Wahab Sheikh resident of Gantamullah Baramulla. Subsequently, both were arrested from court road area of Batmaloo Srinagar.

Further investigation of the case is going on and more recoveries are expected.
