7 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized**STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Stations Miran Sahib, Arnia, Police Posts Sidhra, Chatha and Border Police Post Chakrohi acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 7 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicle include one tractor trolley (JK02CV 5589) by Miran Sahib Police; one tractor trolley bearing Chassis No HZDDG749187S3 by Arnia Police; 3 vehicles i.e. One tractor trolley bearing Chassis number WRTG30405019178 and two tractor trolleys (JK02AW 3053, JK02CC 1359) by Sidhra Police; One tractor trolley bearing Chassis number MBNGAALU2NJC00481, by PP Chatha and One tractor trolley bearing (JK02CK 5317) by Chakrohi Police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Miran Sahib Insp. Zaheer Mushtaq, SHO Arnia Insp. Deepak Katoch, In-charge Police Posts Sidhra PSO Nitish Khajuria, Chatha-PSI Harjinder Paul Singh and Chakrohi-PSI Ishfaq Ahmed Kasana in their respective jurisdictions.

Drug peddler arrested; contraband substance recovered**STATE TIMES NEWS**

BANDIPORA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Tuesday arrested a drug peddler and recovered contraband substances from his possession.

As per the details, a party of Police Station Bari Brahma under the supervision of SHO Bari-Brahma, Insp. Sunil Kumar Sharma and Mohd Usman, DySP Hqrs Samba (Addl. charge of SDPO Bari-Brahma) during patrolling near Haldiram Factory, Balole Nalal, Bari Brahma intercepted two persons moving under suspicious circumstances. During frisking of the said persons by police, approximately 07 gms of Heroin (Chitta) like substance along with cash from their possession.

The accused persons identified as Surmun, son of Choudhary Nawab Deen, resident of Kotey Chorli Tehsil Bishnah at present Bari Brahma and Avinash Menia, son of Romesh Lal, resident of Channi Himmat Jammu have been arrested on the spot and FIR No. 240/2022 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Bari-Brahma.


SHRADHANJALI

Sardar Mohinder Singh Khalsa (Mehta) son of late Bhagat Singh Mehta and Sardarni Paro Devi was born on July 18, 1941 in village Barmang, Rawlakote (Now in PoK). He had six brothers and three sisters. During partition in 1947, the family migrated to Jammu.

He completed MA, M. Ed and joined service as teacher in J&K State Education Department. He got married to Sardarni Narinder Kour who was also a teacher. He was blessed with three daughters and a son who are all married and well settled.

He was a multifaceted person; an academician, historian, poet, good orator and a Union leader who retired from service in 1999 as Headmaster. Both Mohinder Singh Khalsa and his wife were strictly against private tuition. He strongly believed in the teachings of Guru Granth Sahib and meditated regularly. He was very polite, social and helpful to the poor and needy people.

He was greatly shocked due to death of his wife in 2007 and later became a patient of Cancer who lived on liquid diet for five years. He breathed his last on December 23, 2022. He is survived by his three daughters and a son.
