KOLKATA: Under the golden vision, and guidance of Financial Commissioner (Addl. Chief Secretary) of J&K, Atal Dulloo, and constant efforts of Director Horticulture Planning & Marketing, Vikas Sharma, aiming towards realizing Prime Minister's vision of doubling farmers' income and uplifting the Agriculture/ Horticulture sector of J&K, the department of Horticulture Planning & Marketing in collaboration with Invest India (ODOP Team) organized first of its kind Mega Buyer-Seller meet at Kolkata on Saturday. Around 250 participants consisting of buyers from Kolkata, officials of Government of West Bengal, President of Confederation of West Bengal Trade Association and officials of the Horticulture Planning & Marketing attended the event including sellers from J&K-farmers, SHGs, FPOs and entrepreneurs of J&K hailing from different corners of J&K; from remote areas of Kashmir to even border areas of Jammu which were facilitated to travel to Kolkata for meeting delegation of Buyers consisting of big merchants, exporters and giant corporations. The meet was graced by Agriculture Minister of West Bengal Sobhan Deb Chattopadhyay and Commissioner FPI&H Department/Director Food Processing Industries, Government of West Bengal Jayanta Kumar, Director Horticulture Kashmir J&K G.R Mir and Special Secretary to Government Agriculture Production Department, Mohammad Farooq Dar (JKAS).

Director Horticulture (P&M) introduced the department, its role in the Agriculture/Horticulture sector, its growth, various achievements and latest interventions that have been pushed by the department for the betterment of the farming community of J&K. Hailing J&K as a heavenly repertoire of famous high value Horticultural/Agri-cultural products, the Director Horticulture Planning & Marketing presented detailed presentation of the various Agri-cultural/Horticultural products of J&K like Apple, Jammu Basmati, Saffron, Walnut, Guhi (Morel

Mushroom) etc. stressing upon effective promotion, certification, branding and packaging of these products to make them successful not only in National but International markets as well. The Minister applauded the efforts of the UT Govt and posted that meetings. Director Horticulture Kashmir gave detailed information regarding to the Horticulture sector of J&K and the areas where Govt is pushing the horticulture sector stressing that such meets will help farmers to showcase their products directly to the buyers and buyers get in turn exclusive opportunity to deal directly with the producers and get first hand information about their products and enter into lucrative business deals. The buyers were really keen in business opportunities in J&K and it was really motivating for the farmers where most of their samples were bought by the buyers and many giving advance orders. Deposit linked Insurance scheme for G.P. Fund subscribers.

Features:

On event of death of subscriber

1. Legal heir/registered nominee receives additional amount equals to average balance in the account during 3 years immediately preceding death of subscriber.

Conditions:

1. Deceased subscriber should have put in at least 5 years of continuous service
2. Additional amount to be paid should not exceed Rs.60000
3. Average Minimum Balance should not have fallen below the following limits at any time preceding the date of death
 - 1) Rs.25000 in case of Gazetted officers
 2. Rs.15000 in case of Non-Gazetted officials.
 - 3) Rs.10000 in case of class-IV Employees.

Checklist for D.L.I claim:

1. 36 months debit/credit statement of deceased subscriber preceding date of death.
2. Certificate from DDO that the deceased subscriber has rendered more than 5 years of continuous service preceding date of death.
3. Photostat copy of 1st page of service book of deceased subscriber duly attested by DDO.
4. Death certificate

Subject: - Provisional Selection List of eligible candidates for admission to B Pharma Course 2022 in Government/Private Colleges/Institutions of J&K.

Pursuant to Notification No. 094-BOPEE of 2022 dated 28-11-2022, the physical round of counselling of eligible candidates for admission to B Pharma Course-2022 at various Government/Private colleges/Institutions was held on 01-12-2022 simultaneously at BOPEE office Srinagar/Jammu. The list of candidates who participated in the said counselling and have been provisionally selected / allotted seat(s) as per their merit-cum-preferences for the said course is hereby notified as per the Annexure "A" to this Notification which shall remain available on website of the Board (www.jkbopee.gov.in) only. The candidates are advised to report in their respective allotted Colleges/Institutions w.e.f. 02-12-2022 to 10-12-2022 (till 03:00 P.M.) along with following documents: -

1. Marks card of qualifying examinations.
2. Date of birth (10th class marks card/Diploma issued by the Board).
3. Domicile certificate of UT of J&K and for candidates of UT of Ladakh, ST certificate issued by the Competent Authority of Ladakh shall be treated as Domicile Certificate.
4. Valid Reserved Category Certificate, if any, and
5. Any other certificate/document required by the authorities of the Institution concerned

It shall be the sole responsibility of the Institution concerned to ensure proper check and verification of documents / eligibility strictly as per Pharmacy Council of India guidelines before any candidate is allowed for admission.

In order to complete admission process within the specified date, the Institutions shall keep their admission counters open even on holidays/off days and designate Nodal Officers to facilitate the candidates to complete their admission process well in time. However, the candidates in their own interest shall avoid waiting for the last day to complete admission formalities since delay has the potential of causing hardships to the candidates only.

It is hereby implied upon the management of all colleges/institutions to ensure the veracity of documents, particularly the category certificates wherever, the admission is to be granted in lieu of a particular reserved category. The Colleges / Institutions concerned shall ensure that, any candidate(s) with disability, if selected in open merit or some reserved category, it shall be ensured that his/her PwD Certificate/Eligibility is in conformity with Pharmacy Council of India guidelines, regulations framed by the regulatory authority and wherever required shall refer the matter to Medical Board to assess such candidates and make recommendations based on which concerned college shall take further necessary action. In case any such candidate does not fulfill the bench mark of eligibility, he/she shall not be admitted to the course/colleges.

The admission of the candidates is purely provisional and shall be cancelled in case any information furnished by any candidate proves to be false / fabricated, and action as warranted under law shall be initiated against such candidates.

Note: -

1. The candidates who have been allotted seats during the first round of counselling in accordance with their merit / preferences shall have to join the allotted Colleges / Institutions upto 10-12-2022 and in case any candidate fails to join against his /her allotted seat(s) in respective College(s) he / she shall not be eligible to participate in second round of up-gradation/allotment counselling under any circumstances.
2. The seats under TFW Category shall be filled during second round of counselling, as & when held by the Board subject to the condition that 30% of candidates shall be admitted in respective College / Institution as per PCI guidelines.
3. The Colleges/ Institutions shall submit the shortfall, if any, to BOPEE Office, Jammu/Srinagar upto 08:00 P.M. on 10-12-2022 through e-mail jakbopee@gmail.com / helpdesk@jakbopee@gmail.com / coe@jakbopee@gmail.com.

The Annexure-A to this notification shall remain available on the website of the Board www.jkbopee.gov.in only.
