JAMMU: The My Town My Pride 2.0 programme concluded successfully on Tuesday in district Jammu under the overall supervision of Deputy Commissioner Avny Lavasa and with untiring efforts of district officers from various departments.

Multifarious activities were held across all the Municipal areas of Jammu district on the concluding day. All the MCs organised camps at designated venues to spread awareness and impart training to stakeholders, besides conducting plantation drives, special sanitation drives and other activities.

The main event was organised at Gulshan Ground Jammu at which more than 40

departments put up their counters to facilitate the general public. Besides the MTMP was also conducted at Town Hall, Convention Centre, PWD Guest House Gandhi Nagar, Engineering Institute Channi Himmat and Auditorium of Polytechnic Shiv Nagar comprising five zones of JMC.
