

# PMG J&K reviews progress of postal services in three districts of Jammu region

JAMMU: A review meeting of three major districts of J&K was carried out by Col Vinod Kumar, Postmaster General, Jammu & Kashmir in connection with the progress of departmental services including Rail Post Gati Shakti Express Cargo Service in which representatives of three districts viz. Jammu, Rajouri and Udhampur participated and projected their achievements and efforts in Nodal Delivery Center of Jammu Tawi. Sandeep Kumar Postal Assistant welcomed all the representatives and gave a brief of the the program. During the meeting, Col Vinod Kumar, PMG Jammu laid special focus on Joint Parcel Product (JPP) of India Post, a joint venture of India Post and Indian Railways.

He explained about services called First And Last Mile Services' requirements of manufacturers in Jammu & Kashmir can be catered by newly introduced Mobile Parcel Van service. This has been started to collect the parcel from the doorstep of the cus-

tomers in J&K. After pick up of Articles/ parcels from the door step of the customer the parcels are to be handed over to railway authorities.

A new software called PMS has been developed especially for this requirement. In the process consignments will be locked in specially customized containers in the presence of representatives of both the departments.

The PMG was also briefed that parcels booked under JPP will be fully insured for which M/s Bajaj Alliance General Insurance Company is already

on boarded as per the agreements done in Delhi.

Guiding participants about marketing techniques, Col Vinod Kumar told them that the role of marketing team plays a very significant role in terms of spreading awareness about the services of the government and through these knowledge businessmen and manufacturers get benefitted.

He also briefed about various services provided by the Department of Posts like BNPL, COD, Business parcels etc on the reasonable rates and reliable time norms. At last of

the review meet Col Vinod Kumar said that the all the stakeholders of J&K may be apprised about the services provided by the Department of Posts which is possible only with whole hearted efforts of Post family of J&K circle.

All J&K Plus Two Lecturers' Forum calls on Piyush Singla, seeks ACP for cadre

JAMMU: A delegation of All J&K Plus Two Lecturers' Forum led by its President Pardeep Singh Rakwal called on Administrative Secretary, GAD Piyush Singla to discuss their long pending demand of ACP. The President discussed the matter in detail with the Secretary who assured that same would be resolved. The forum submitted the memorandum regarding the same showing comparative statement of Time-bound promotion pattern in gazetted cadre of other departments. The forum also submitted a memorandum to Principal Secretary SED, Alok Kumar and met Director Finance SED, Iftikhar Hussain Chauhan.

Speaking on the occasion, Rakwal alleged that discrimination with 10+2 Lecturers amongst Gazetted cadre has deprived them of Assured Progression Scheme (ACP/Time bound promotion) despite repeated requests, memorandum and assurances from various previous dispensations. He hoped that UT administration led by LG Manoj Sinha will resolve the long pending issue of ACP/TBP pertaining to plus two cadre by sanctioning three time bound promotions, within a span of 20 years on the analogy of their other counterparts in Gazetted cadre of different departments.

The forum also urged for early regularisation of incharge lecturers who have been promoted as lecturers in various disciplines.
