## Narayana Hospital performs highly complex joint replacement surgery

KATRA: Under the leadership of Senior Joint Replacement Surgeon, Dr.Vikas Padha, the Orthopaedics department at SMVD Narayana Hospital, Katra, has achieved yet another remarkable feat. They recently completed a highly complex joint replacement surgery on a patient grappling with Advanced Osteoarthritis of Both Knees coupled with complex "Wind Swept" deformities.

The patient, 63-year-old Sawal Singh from the remote Ram Nagar area of Udhampur District, experienced an unimaginable transformation. After years of enduring discomfort, he found himself walking effortlessly without any aid. Singh's condition involved severe osteoarthritis in both knees, compounded by a challenging "Wind Swept" deformity wherein one knee was bent inwards and the other knee bent outwards. Despite seeking counsel from several medical professionals across

Jammu and beyond J&K, he had resigned to the belief that walking again was an unattainable dream. His case was deemed complex, with a daunting price tag for treatment, further diminishing his hopes owing to his poor socio-economic background.



However, a glimmer of hope emerged when the patient consulted Senior Orthopaedics and Joint Replacement Surgeon Dr.Vikas Padha at

SMVD Narayana Hospital, Katra. Dr.Padha not only instilled confidence in a successful surgical intervention but also informed Singh about the Ayushman Bharat Scheme, assuring him that the entire cost of surgery would be covered.

Sawal Singh underwent Knee Replacement for one joint in July, followed by the other knee joint two months later; both performed entirely free under the Ayushman

Bharat Yojna. Reflecting on the complexity of the case, Senior Joint Replacement Surgeon Dr. Vikas Padha remarked, "Treating such intricate deformities demanded an extremely high level of surgical expertise along with specialized implants. We successfully operated on both knee joints separately, two months apart. I extend my heartfelt gratitude to the management of SMVD Narayana Hospital Katra, including Clinical Director Dr. JP Singh and Facility Director M. M. Mathavan, for their unwavering support in facilitating these complex surgeries, including sourcing the specialized implants required for this procedure."

Dr. Padha emphasized that while such complex surgeries are common place in larger cities across India, SMVD Narayana Hospital Katra has now established itself as a hub where these procedures are routinely conducted, bringing advanced medical care to the region.

**ORDER**

Whereas, it has been observed that two wheeler riders and Pillion riders are riding without wearing helmets thereby endangering their lives as well as threatening the lives of the others particularly the roadside walkers; and


Whereas, riding two wheeler without helmet is an offence under the Motor Vehicle Act.

Whereas, District Administration has taken a serious note of such issues and in order to ensure better road discipline and to deter such violators of traffic laws, some additional stringent measures should be in place in the larger interest of the public.

Now, therefore, in view of above, I, **Dr. Rakesh Minhas, IAS, District Magistrate Kathua** in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 144 CrPC do hereby order the following action to be taken by the concerned with immediate effect in the interest of security and safety of health and life of public at large:-

- No Petrol Pump Station/Filling Station in District Kathua shall sell/refill the fuel to any two wheeler rider who is without helmet and a rule of "**NO HELMET NO PETROL**" shall be enforced within the jurisdiction of District Kathua.
- All Petrol Pump owners shall compulsorily install the CCTV cameras with DVR in their fuel outlets clearly indicating the footage of fuel buyers. All the Executive Magistrates 1<sup>st</sup> Class are authorized to check the footage of petrol pumps/filling stations and recommend action against the defaulters to the undersigned.
- Time period of ten days is being given to all the petrol pumps/filling stations for installation of CCTV cameras for proper recording of two wheeler fuel buyers.
- The Tehsildars in their respective territorial jurisdiction shall execute this order and cause the service of this order upon all the petrol pumps, under intimation to the undersigned.
- Appropriate action as warranted under laws shall be taken against Petrol Pumps selling fuel to such traffic violators.
- Tehsildar Kathua shall explore the possibility of establishment of stalls in the premises of DC Office Complex and at other prominent places for selling helmets at reasonable discounted rates for the general public. This order will come in force w.e.f 15-12-2023 and any violation of this order shall invite strict punitive action under section 188 of Indian Penal Code.
