The Solid Waste Management program aims to implement effective and scientific waste management practices in Block shangus District Anantnag, in line with the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen). The program will cover the 18 Panchayat Halgas of CD Block Shangus comprising 18 Gram Panchayats in single cluster:

2. SCOPE OF WORK:

under: -

The contracting agency will be responsible for the following processes:

Solid Waste Collection

- a) Sanitation and door-to-door collection of both biodegradable and nonbiodegradable waste from all households of Block Shangus details of HHs and commercial establishment is givenin above table covering all households, shops, factories, industrial establishments, etc. at least thrice a week.
- b) A Panchayat-Halqa-wise schedule of waste collection shall further be notified in consultation with the agency who shall be awarded bid after opening of Bid.
- c) The intending agency shall collect all types of waste- door-to-door waste, waste from already installed dustbins, and legacy waste so that the objective of ODF plus is obtained.
- d) Ensuring segregation of waste preferably at the household level and mandatorily at the already constructed segregation shed sites.
- e) Effective and scientific management and disposal of collected waste in an environmentally sustainable manner. A weekly review/report shall be submitted by concerned secretary panchayat to this office to ascertain the effectiveness of weekly disposal.

Revenue Collection

- a) Conducting a fresh survey, in consultation with the field functionaries of the Rural Development Department, to update the household data and include commercial factories, business units, institutions, shops, etc. Collection of monthly Fees/ Charges from the households preferably in digital mode.
- b) Revenue generation through sustainable waste management practices, such as selling segregated dry waste to authorized dealers.
- c) X% (to be decided through EOI) of the Fee/user charges so collected has to be deposited in the bank account of the concerned Gram Panchayat on a monthly basis.

Maintenance

- a) Maintenance and upkeep of departmental garbage collection vehicles which shall be provided after purchasing of vehicles which is in process, and e-rickshaws (ready for Use) used for waste collection and ensuring their dedicated use only for solid waste
- b) The Vehicles used for waste collection shall be departmental only and the agency has to use these Vehicles/e-rickshaws by engaging its own staff and ensuring the vehicle's maintenance in all respects.
- c) The intending agency shall be responsible for the smooth handing over of all assets (Vehicles/machinery/Civil Structures and possession of the sites in good condition to the concerned department after completing the allotment of one year (without any

Manpower & Machinery

- a) The contracting agency has to engage sweepers/ waste collectors, labour for segregation of waste collected at segregation sheds. Drivers, and Management staff with a unique uniform having a SBM logo, the design and details of which shall be conveyed to the contracting agency later.
- b) The contracting agency has to operate and maintain all the e-carts, garbage collection vans, and machinery at its own level and has to bear the electricity, POL, and maintenance /repair charges of the machinery. The contracting agency will be required to obtain necessary permissions/approvals from the BDO Shangus for repair, and maintenance of the existing machinery, if required, at any time.

Dispute Resolution and Penal provision

a) In case of any dispute, the Block Development Officer of the concerned Block shallbe the

first appellate authority, the 2nd appellate authority shall be the Assistant Commissione Panchayats Anantnag and the third appellate & final authority shall be the District Level Committee for implementation of SBM-G with Deputy Commissioner Ananthag as its Chairperson. b) The contracting agency shall have to report to the Block Development Officer of the

IEC endeavors and inciting behavioral change

The means could be composing appealing and effective sanitation jingles played through overhead speakers of waste collection vehicles on a regular basis, organizing special sanitation drives by involving local youth clubs, students, and Self Help Groups, organizing monthly felicitation ceremonies for best cooperative and complying Panchayats in consultation with the BDO concerned and the District administration, etc... Monthly IEC plans, 10 days in advance, to be submitted to the concerned BDO for review and approval.
- b) The contracting agency shall influence the general public through its best possible sanitation services and shall motivate and convince them to segregate the waste at the source besides reducing the use of Single Use Plastics.
