Earlier, she conducted a comprehensive review of the progress and initiatives within the Animal Husbandry sector in Kishtwar district on Friday. Accompanied by Dr. Nadeem Ahmed, Extension Officer of the Publicity Wing, Animal Husbandry Department Jammu, the visit to district Kishtwar aimed at assessing the status of various programs and schemes.
Dr. Shubhra Sharma inaugurated the Tehsil Unit Kishtwar Building and Animal Operation Theater at Veterinary Complex Kishtwar. Later, the Director Husbandry Department

Jammu met a delegation of Paravets association (Technical Field Staff Association) Kishtwar presence of Dr. Ajaz Hussain Patagaroo, CAHO. Dr. Shubhra assured them that all their genuine demands will be fulfilled. Director Animal Husbandry Jammu along with CAHO Kishtwar Dr. Ajaz Hussain today visited Nagseni and Padder Blocks of Kishtwar District. During her visit she inaugurated the

newly constructed Livestock Development centre Building at Dool village and met with Self Help group members and the Public of Nagseni Block. During the interactive session, Dr. Shubhra Sharma attentively listened to the issues and concerns raised by the public. She assured them that all their issues will be resolved and Veterinary services will be strengthened in Kishtwar District.
Dr. Sharma visited Padder area of Kishtwar District, the last corner of J&K UT. This is the first time that Director Animal Husbandry visited Padder. Director Animal Husbandry Jammu along with CAHO Kishtwar inaugurated Walk in Cold room facility at Sub-unit Gulabgarh for maintenance of cold chain. She met Public Representatives of Padder Block who demanded stocking of adequate medicine at Veterinary centres of Padder. Dr. Shubhra assured them

that demand will be fulfilled and on the spot directions for the same were issued. She also engaged with Self-Help Groups at Community Hall Gulabgarh Padder. This interaction facilitated a closer understanding of community needs and aspirations within the ambit of animal husbandry initiatives. In a significant gesture towards boosting the animal husbandry infrastructure, Dr. Shubhra Sharma allotted funds for procurement of Ultrasound and X-ray machines at TU Kishtwar and Sub unit Atholi and augmentation of PDC Kishtwar so that Poultry farming sector in District Kishtwar can be boosted

Furthermore, during the introductory sessions, the accredited Agent for Health and Extension of Livestock Production programme commonly known as A-HELP was discussed within the participants and its importance in economic growth of rural women populace was taken on board.
Dr Manzoor and Dr Waseem from the department of Animal Husbandry Shopian

highlighted the importance of Milk Analysis and also discussed within the participants the methods and processes for appropriate recording of milk and selection of breeds for dairy farming.
They emphasized on proper fodder consultation practices which could transform the basic structuring of livestock business for better production and cost reduction per liter of milk which will directly lead to better income generation of households.
At the concluding session, more 25 Kits were distributed on the spot among the identified farm CRPs.

Sub:- Safety Measures against Fire incidents In Hotels / Guest Houses – Issuance of Section 144 Cr.PC thereof.

ORDER

Whereas, fire incidents are a grave threat to life and property and during the winter season, the threat of fire incidents multiplies due to the high usage of heating appliances.

Whereas, certain guidelines have already been put in place to deal with fire incidents and all the hoteliers / guest houses etc. have also been obligated to follow these guidelines to deal with fire incidents.

Whereas, this office has also received a letter from the Assistant Director, Fire & Emergency Services Command, Doda, wherein he has intimated that a number of hotels / guest houses in District Doda have not adopted any Fire Safety Measures.

Whereas, fire incidents were recently witnessed in tourist destination Sanasar, due to non-adherence to fire safety measures.

In view of the above, I, Dr. R.K Bharti, JKAS, Addl. District Magistrate, Doda, in exercise of the powers vested in me vide S.O 195 dated:- 08.06.2021, do hereby order under section 144 of Cr.PC that every hotel, guest house etc. in District Doda shall adhere to fire safety measures viz-a-viz installation of fixed fire safety measures and first aid fire fighting system, proper storage of water exclusively for fire-fighting purposes etc. within a period of one month.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Doda shall ensure the implementation of this order in letter and spirit. Since it is not possible to serve this order individually, it is hereby issued ex-parte and shall be circulated in print, electronic and social media for the information of all concerned. Any violation in this behalf shall be dealt under the relevant provisions of Law.
