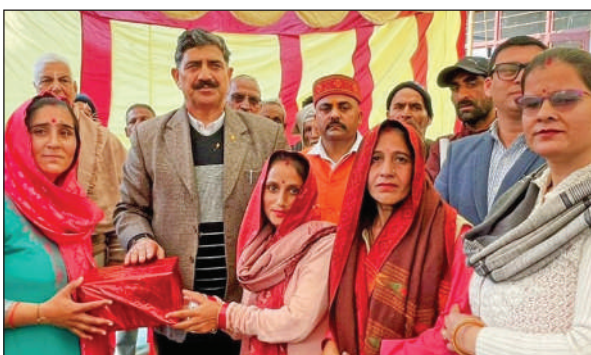
The VBSY Van, upon arrival, was welcomed with flower petals, setting the stage for the display of the PM's message and the achievements under different government schemes in Pounthal.
