SAMBHA: Principal Secretary, PWD (R&B), Shailendra Kumar on Tuesday chaired a Public Darbar at Anandpur panchayat of Purmandal block here, to address community issues and concerns.

The event recorded several crucial issues pertaining to road connectivity in Khara upper and lower areas besides Karad, Amla and Sumb areas, construction of bridge at Madana, road repairs, construction of bridge from Uttarbehni to Sangar, finalization of DPR for Health and Wellness Centre at Katwala Panchayat and construction of well in Deon area.

A comprehensive memorandum of demands was submitted by Avtar Singh, DDC member Purmandal, and Arshad Begum, BDC Chairman Purmandal. Besides, DDC Vice Chairperson Samba, Balwan Singh also submitted a memorandum of demands with request to enhance connectivity in remote block of Sumb.

Pharmacy (Excluding ANM & GNM) Courses-2023 in Government/Private Colleges/Institutions of UT of J&K/Ladakh for filling up of short fall of seats received from various Colleges / Institutions and the seats which have remained unfilled after conclusion of 1st Round of Counselling it is hereby notified for information of the concerned candidates who have participated in the counselling process that the list of candidates who have been provisionally upgraded / allotted seats during the Counselling is annexed as Annexure-A to this notification which shall remain available on official website of the Board viz. www.jkbopee.gov.in only.

The Provisionally Upgraded/Selected candidate are advised to report to their respective allotted Colleges/Institutions for completion of admission formalities upto 03rd January, 2024 till 04.00 p.m. along with the following documents in original: -

- Domicile Certificate.
- D.O.B Certificate (Matriculation Certificate from the Board of School Education)
- Marks Sheet of 12th Class.
- Category Certificate, wherever applicable.
- Any other document as may be required by the concerned College.

It shall be the sole responsibility of the concerned College/Institution to ensure proper check and verification of documents/eligibility as per guidelines J&K Paramedical Council and All India Paramedical Council before the candidate is allowed for admission and in case of any discrepancy in the requisite documents/eligibility the same shall be reported to the Board for further course of action under rules.

It is hereby implored upon the management of all the concerned Colleges/ Institutions to ensure the veracity of documents, particularly the Category Certificates wherever the admission is to be granted in lieu of a Reserved Category. So far as the Persons with Disability are concerned, if selected under Open Merit or against a Reserved Category, it shall be ensured that his / her PwD Certificate / eligibility is in conformity with INC guidelines & as per Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 and wherever required shall refer the matter to the concerned Medical Board i.e. Government Medical College Jammu / Government Medical College Srinagar to assess the disability of such candidate(s) and make recommendations that if the candidate does not fulfil benchmarks of eligibility, he / she shall not be admitted to the course/college and the matter shall be reported to the Board for further course of action.

In order to complete the admission process within the prescribed cut-off date (03.01.2024), the concerned Colleges/Institutions shall keep their admission counters open even on holidays/off days to facilitate the candidates to complete their admission process well in time. However, the candidates in their own interest avoid waiting for last day to complete admission formalities since delay has the potential of causing hardships to the candidates only.

Pursuant to Notification No. 134-BOPEE of 2023 dated 07.12.2023, the Board has received short fall from Government/Private Colleges/Institutions running 10th Based Paramedical Diploma (MMPHW/FMPHW) Courses-2023 in Government/Private Colleges/Institutions in the UT of J&K/Ladakh. To fill up the seats received as short-fall and the seats which have remained unfilled after conclusion of 1st Round of counselling, it is hereby notified that the Board shall conduct the 2nd/Mop-up Round of Physical Counselling for allotment/up-gradation of seats to the eligible candidates for admission to these Courses as per the following schedule: -

After conclusion of the Counselling for the Reserved Categories on 29.12.2023, the unfilled Reserved Category Seats, if any, shall be converted into Open Merit as per Section-9 of J&K Reservation Act, 2004 and filled up accordingly from amongst the Open Merit Candidates. However, the candidates who may not get any seat under their Reserved Category, can participate in the Counselling process as an Open Merit Candidate on his/her date of Counselling subject to the condition that he/she is eligible under the Open Merit category.

Note:

The following procedure shall be adopted during the conduct of 2nd/Mop-up round of Counselling: -

- All the interested and eligible candidates are advised to report at the BOPEE Office Srinagar/Jammu on their respective day/date of counselling from 9.00 a.m. to 10.30 a.m. for registration and fulfilment of other formalities.
- The candidates who have been allotted seats during 1st Round of Counselling but have failed to join in the allotted College shall also be eligible for 2nd/Mop-up Round of Counselling.
- All the participating candidates are advised to bring along the following documents in original for check and verification at the time of Counselling: -
a. Domicile Certificate.
b. 10th Class Marks Card.
c. D.O.B Certificate issued by the Board.
d. Category Certificate, wherever applicable.
e. PwD Certificate, wherever applicable.
- Those candidates who have remained absent or got CNA or SNA during 1st Round of Counselling shall also be eligible to participate in this 2nd/Mop-up Round of Counselling.
- It is enjoined upon all the eligible candidates that they shall visit/attend Counselling only after checking the Seat Matrix to be made available on the official website viz. www.jkbopee.gov.in of the Board before the day of counselling.
- The candidates who have been allotted seat(s) during 1st Round of Counselling and have joined against the said Seat/College, if interested, shall be eligible to participate in the 2nd/Mop-up Round for up-gradation/allotment, subject to the condition that these candidates shall have to bring along the receipt of admission fee deposited in the allotted College for check/verification during the counselling.
