**STATE TIMES NEWS** JAMMU: Justice Rajesh Sekhri of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court, while dealing with the tender matter; observed that Principles of judicial review are attracted to the exercise of contractual powers by Government and its instrumentalities and High courts are vested with the "tender jurisdiction" under Article 226 of the Constitution to ensure greater accountability and transparency. However, "tender jurisdiction" is to be exercised by the High Court in rarest of rare cases on very limited grounds on the anvil of Article 14 of the Microscopic Constitution. examination of the terms and conditions of a contract, by the review court is not permissible. The public authority issuing a tender notice is at liberty to grant any relaxation for a bonafide reason and such relaxation is binding on the bidders.

CVC/administrative Guidelines are recommendatory in nature and cannot be enforced through Courts.
