NEW DELHI: Addressing the first-ever meeting of the BRIC Society after its registration on 10th November, 2023 after getting the Cabinet approval, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh said here today that time has come for defining "Bio-vision" for Bharat.

Dr Jitendra today said that the new Apex Autonomous The senior BJP leader Society called Biotechnology Research and Innovation Council (BRIC) will fulfil Prime Minister Narendra Vision for Atma Modi's Nirbhar Bharat in areas like healthcare, food and energy needs by scaling biotech research and innovation.

He said, in the last eight vears, the biotech sector has grown eightfold times.

The Minister quoted PM Modi as saying, "India is not too far from reaching the league of top-10 countries in Biotech's global ecosystem". He added that BRIC is going to be a testimony to this and again by inculcating the spirit of Sabka Prayas, the government is bringing together the best minds on a unified plat-
