Traffic advisory for New Year celebration

JAMMU: The Traffic Police Jammu on Saturday advised the general public visiting the hotels and other establishments hosting the New Year party to use specific traffic spaces for parking the vehicles and avoid random and roadside parking.

The revelers are advised to park their vehicles at nearby/specified parking places only and shall not park anywhere on the roadside as the same causes unnecessary jamming and congestion.

It is informed that strict action shall be taken against drunken driving, speeding, stunt biking, reckless driving, dangerous driving. Special focus will be given on stunt biking, motorists are informed not to perform stunt biking which endangers their life as well as other people.

Operations of 27 erring drug sale establishments suspended in Jammu Div

JAMMU: To ensure availability of genuine and quality medicines/medical products for the end-users/patients, a special drive is being carried out regularly in Jammu Province under the supervision of Concerned Empowered Authorities. The drive is being conducted under the overall supervision of Mohammad Iqbal Palla, Deputy Drugs Controller, Jammu. The main objective of the drive is to ensure availability of quality medicines and to curb the unethical sale of medicinal formulations prone to cause intoxication.

During the drive, Operations of Twenty Seven Drug Sale Establishments (Eighteen in Jammu (Retail/Wholesale) , Two each in Udhampur, Reasi & Rajouri Districts , One each in Doda, Kathua & Kishtwar) were disallowed for indulging in violation of the provisions of Drugs & Cosmetics Act,1940 & rules there-under.

The licenses were subsequently suspended and the defaulters have been warned to desist from any malpractices.

Statutory Drug samples of nearly One Hundred Fifty formulations of various categories in particular lesser known and fast moving brands were lifted randomly for determination of strength, purity and other quality parameters. These samples have been referred to Drug Testing Laboratories located for framing of legal opinion w.r.t quality parameters.

Awareness/Sensitization Programs were initiated involving the youth and other stake-holders in different areas in coordination with the Officers of District Administration to propagate awareness regarding the menace of substance abuse and its dangerous ill-effects.

Accused facing trial under different sections of Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940 in Six Court cases have been penalized by the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jammu where a penalty of more than Rs 8.00 Lakh has been imposed on the accused along with imprisonment (TRC) in some cases.

Recently, Licensing Authorities (Wholesale & Retail) of Jammu Province have cancelled more than Hundred non-operative/non-existing Drugs Sale Licenses to

avoid their misuse by nefarious elements.

Moreover, Stocks of Drugs worth Rs 19,000 that were found to be contravening the provisions of the D&C Act have also been confiscated from the supply chain by the Regulatory Officers of the organization.

Lotika Khajuria, State Drugs Controller, J&K has once again impressed upon the Pharma fraternity to strictly adhere to the conditions of licenses and desist from any unlawful activity. The Empowered Drug Control Authorities have been impressed upon to ensure the installation of CCTV Cameras and impress upon Chemists to adopt computerized system of billing for maintenance of records in larger.

Jammu CB chargesheets Nagpur-based man for Rs 1.70-Cr fraud

JAMMU: The Crime Branch of Jammu and Kashmir Police on Saturday filed a chargesheet against a resident of Maharashtra for allegedly cheating a businessman of Rs 1.70 crore on the pretext of supplying food grains in 2019, an official said.

The Economic Offences Wing of the Crime Branch, Jammu, presented a 504-page chargesheet in a court here against accused Parvin Kumar Ninawe, a resident of Nagpur in Maharashtra for allegedly defrauding Suresh Gupta, proprietor of the Shona Trust Corporation, a spokesman of the agency said.

Gupta is engaged in the business of sale-purchase and supply of food grains and other allied products to the government as well as to the public.

Gupta, in his complaint to Jammu Crime Branch, alleged that he made payment of Rs 3.11 crore to the accused from time to time but the accused supplied goods worth only Rs 1.41 crore to him and the remaining amount was neither returned nor any goods were supplied by the accused, the spokesman said.

He said the accused also issued a cheque of Rs 60 lakh to the complainant but it was dishonoured by the bank.

On receipt of the complaint, a preliminary verification was conducted and during the course of inquiry the allegations made were prima-facie substantiated leading to the registration of a formal case under the relevant sections, the spokesman said.

He said the offences under section 420 (cheating) of the Indian Penal Code are established against Ninawe, who is on bail.

One year imprisonment to Property Dealer in Cheque Bounce case

JAMMU: Chief Judicial Magistrate Jammu Anjum Ara on Saturday awarded one year imprisonment and fine Rs 10,000 to property dealer Shashi Mahajan in cheque bounce case.

Court further ordered that Accused shall also pay compensation of Rs 35 laes to the complainant which includes cheque amount of Rs. 25 lakh and 10 lakh being the compensation for the loss and damages sustained due to non payment by the accused since November 14, 2007 with interest @ 6 per cent per annum till its realisation.

It is alleged in the complaint that the accused is a property dealer and deals in the business of sale and purchase of landed property. The complainant is the lawful owner of the landed property situated at Channi Bijja Tehsil Jammu. Therefore, in order to discharge the legal and enforceable liability pertaining to the land transaction, the accused issued a Payee's Account Cheque No.062027 under A/c 1460000101105935, dated November 14, 2007 for an amount of Rs.25.00 Lakh (Rs. Twenty-five Lakh) to be drawn at Punjab National Bank Branch Shastri Nagar Jammu in favour of the complainant. The accused assured the complainant that the aforesaid cheque shall be encashed as and when the same is presented in the bank, therefore, the complainant accepted the cheque and accordingly the com-

DB seeks UT response on Shah Kul's restoration

JAMMU: In a Public Interest Litigation (PIL), seeking to remove "illegal encroachments" and the restoration of the original status of 'Shah Kul', a canal of historical importance and a national monument, a Division Bench of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court Comprising Chief Justice N Kotiswar Singh and Justice M A Chowdhary issued notice to the J&K government through its Chief Secretary, Vice Chairman, Lake Conservation and Management Authority Srinagar, Secretary Lakes and Conservation and Management Authority, Srinagar, Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir, Deputy Commissioner (DC) Srinagar, Director, Land Records Srinagar, Commissioner Srinagar Municipality, DG Archaeological Survey of India, Director Gardens and Parks, Chief Engineer, PHE Srinagar, Chief Engineer, PW(R&B) Srinagar and others.

DB also issued notice to two private persons from Deewan Colony Ishber Nishat for their response to the PIL to be filed by or before February 21.

In response to the submission by advocate Khuroo on behalf of the petitioner, Mir Muhammad Shafi, that two private persons (respondent Nos.18 and 19) engaged in illegal construction by raising the concrete walls, the court said: "DB make it clear that, if any, illegal construction is made without following the due process of law, the same will be at their risk and will be dealt with by law."

Three extortionists arrested, extorted money recovered

JAMMU: Police on Saturday solved two extortion cases within 72 hours by arresting three accused persons posing as police personnel.

An information was received through reliable sources that some persons posing themselves as policemen were involved in a snatching incident in broad daylight, from a street hawker (Pheriwal) in Bishnah town, by posing themselves as In-charge Chowki Officer of JK Police, and extorted money from the street hawker, while the duo were in a Maruti Alto car.

Again similar information was received from Dablehar R.S Pura, where an egg seller reported that some unknown persons have extorted Rs 2000 rupees from him, along with his mobile phone, by posing themselves as In-charge Chowki Officer of JK Police, while driving an Alto car.

In both these separate incidents which happened in the broad day light, two FIRs were lodged and special teams of both the police stations i.e PS Bishnah and PS RS Pura, were constituted. Police teams led by SHO Bishnah and SHO RS Pura did strenuous efforts and with the help of various CCTV footages of the areas finally rounded up the three accused persons. During questioning accused confessed their involvement in the above case and on their disclosure extorted money along with vehicle used for commission of offence was seized.

The accused arrested identified as Akhil Chopra, son of Prem Chopra, resident of RS Pura; Roshan, son of Bachan Lal, resident of Sidhrey, R.S Pura and Nitin Kumar, son of Naresh Kumar R/O R.S Pura.
