KISHTWAR: SSP Kishtwar, Khalil Poswal chaired a meeting at DPO Kishtwar to review ongoing cases and assess those under trial. During the meeting, Poswal-JKPS emphasized revisiting directives from the Police Headquarters regarding UAPA case investigations. He urged efficient handling of UAPA cases, highlighting expedited, result-oriented investigations to dismantle the terror ecosystem.

Instructing a more serious approach to investigations and the implementation of action plans, SSP Kishtwar called for effective, timely chargesheets and emphasized the importance of

identifying and prosecuting all individuals involved in supporting terrorists, not just the perpetrators. He directed stringent action against Over-Ground Workers (OGWs) and support networks, including the seizure of accused individuals' property under the law and declaring absconding individuals as 'proclaimed offenders.'

SSP Kishtwar Poswal urged supervisory officers to analyze UAPA/NDPS cases, initiating investigations with sensitivity. Emphasizing the need for a swift investigative process and improved conviction rates, he stressed the importance of foolproof investigations, considering all evidence and planning trials meticulously. Pairvi Cells have been established at

various levels to support the investigation process, with officers directed to supervise them for enhanced conviction rates. The meeting was attended by all supervisory officers, including Dy. SP Hqrs Dr. Ishan Gupta, SDPO Marwah Devindar Singh, Dy. SP PC Vishal Sharma, Dy. SP DAR Sajjad Khan, SDPO Atholi Praladsh Sharma.

Whereas, the Jammu and Kashmir Services Selection Board

(JKSSB), advertised these 89 posts as per the category-wise breakup given herein above, vide Notification No. 01 of 2022 dated 27.01.2022, for seeking applications from the eligible candidates. The cut-off date for the receipt of the online application form was 10.03.2022. As per the method of recruitment notified for these posts, 80% weight-age was earmarked to the performance of the candidates in the OMR Test and the Skill/Type Test carried 20% weight-age; and

Whereas, the Board, accordingly, conducted the Skill Test/Type Test for these posts w.e.f. 09.02.2023 to 11.02.2023 and the Result/Score-sheet, depicting the performance of the candidates in the Skill Test/Type Test (computer based), was notified vide No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM(UT)/23/2023-03(7124203) dated 23.02.2023. This was followed by the conduct of OMR Based Written Examination and, vide Notification No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM(UT)/65/2023-04(7263889) dated 04.10.2023, the Result/Merit List of the candidates in the aforesaid Written Exam post was notified; and

Whereas, the schedule of the submission of offline preferences and Document Verification (DV) of the candidates falling under the consideration zone was notified vide Notification No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM(UT)/65/2023-04(7263889) dated 07.10.2023 and Supplementary Document Verification (DV) vide No. JKSSB-COE0EXAM(UT)/65/2023-04(7263889) dated 13.10.2023; and

Whereas, the JKSSB, vide Office Order No. 228-SSB of 2023 dated 13.10.2023, constituted a Selection Committee for preparing the Selection List for these 89 posts of Junior Assistant/Junior Assistant-cum-Computer Operator, Department of Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction, advertised vide Notification No. 01 of 2022 dated 27.01.2022, under item Nos. 001-017; and

Whereas, the Provisional Selection List for the aforementioned posts, prepared as per the merit/eligibility of the candidates and having regard to the extant rules/regulations, was placed before the Board at its 242th meeting held on 02.11.2023, which, after due deliberations and consideration of the matter, approved its notification; and

Whereas, the provisional Selection List was notified vide Notification No. JKSSB/SD/Secy/JMU-2023-03(E-7322624) dated 06.11.2023, wherein candidates were provided opportunity to submit their representations/grievances, if any, within five days; and

Whereas, the representations received from the candidates have been examined by the Selection Committee for necessary action. Further, no candidate is available under SC and ST category. Therefore, in accordance with the procedure defined in Government Order No. 10-DMRRR of 2019 dated 06.03.2019, issued by Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction, all 13 unfilled reserved category vacancies under SC/ST categories (10=SC and 03=ST), have been de-reserved and utilized under Open Merit.
