JAMMU: In a breakthrough in the fight against drug menace, a drug peddler has been apprehended by the Jammu Police. Acting on specific intelligence, a team led by SHO Police Station Peer Mitha, assisted by ICPP Gujjar Nagar, under the close supervision of SDPO City North Jammu conducted an operation in the Gujjar Nagar area, under the guidance of SP City North, Jammu leading to the arrest of one individual.
