Crime Branch arrests property dealer, 9 others for forgery, cheating

JAMMU: Jammu Wing of Crime Branch on Friday arrested 10 people from different districts of Jammu and Kashmir or their involvement in frauds, forgery and cheating.

Senior Superintendent of Police, Crime Branch Jammu, Benam Tosh said these accused have been arrested in seven FIRs registered against them between 2013 and 2024 under vari-

ous sections of law. Separate teams of Crime Branch conducted series of raids in Jammu, Ramban, Samba and Budgam districts after offences of criminal conspiracy, fraud, forgery and cheating were proved against the 10 accused on the basis of sufficient documentary, oral and scientific evidences, he said.

The arrested accused included notorious property dealer Anil Chopra, son of

Sardar Deva Singh, resident of Sainik Colony Jammu against whom two FIRs are registered in Crime Branch, Sourabh Manhas, Dev Raj of Jammu, Bilal Ahmad of Badgam, Atta Mohd of Ramban, Rakesh and Rohit of Jammu, Babu and Bishan Dass of Samba and one lady accused of Jammu.

(*AEPS - Aadhaar Enabled Payment System)



Be aware of these rules and prevent yourself from frauds



Rule 1: Verify credentials of the Business Correspondent/Operator by asking for an ID proof



Rule 2: Check if any additional paper/transparent film, etc. is attached to the fingerprint scanning device



Rule 3: Insist on a transaction slip and check details for every AEPS transaction, even failed transactions

Remember, if an SMS is received that a transaction has been made without your authorisation, report it to your bank immediately.
