Drug Control measures in Jammu Dist reviewed

JAMMU: Taking a firm stance against drug abuse, District Magistrate Jammu Sachin Kumar Vaishva on Thursday called for outlining a comprehensive strategy to combat the menace in the district.

Chairing the meeting of the District Level Narcotics Coordination (NCORD) Committee, the DM directed the involvement of Drug Inspectors in all drugsrelated raids and inspections. He further emphasised on conducting joint inspections led by SDMs, SDPOs and SPs.

Focussing on rehabilitation aspects, the DM called for systematic monitoring of registered drug addicts. "Regular assessment of improvement and relapse conditions is essential for effective control of drug abuse," he stated, directing officers to maintain detailed statistics of registered cases

The meeting also raised concerns over the probable abuse of Schedule H drugs prescription medications that require strict monitoring and can only be dispensed under valid pre-The DM scriptions. instructed the Assistant Drugs Controller and local police to conduct regular and surprise inspections in their jurisdictions.

A major thrust was given to preventive measures as the District Magistrate outlined the roadmap for declaring Drug-Free Panchayats and Urban Local Bodies. He also stressed on strict implementation of the Cigarettes OtherTobacco Products Act (COTPA) effectively.

SSP Joginder Singh emphasised enhanced interdepartmental coordination and stressed on strict enforcement of law and order to prevent the escalation of drug-related issues in the district.
