

Drug Control measures in Jammu Dist reviewed

JAMMU: Taking a firm stance against drug abuse, District Magistrate Jammu Sachin Kumar Vaishya on Thursday called for outlining a comprehensive strategy to combat the menace in the district.

Chairing the meeting of the District Level Narcotics Coordination (NCORD) Committee, the DM directed the involvement of Drug Inspectors in all drugs-related raids and inspections. He further emphasised on conducting joint inspections led by SDMs, SDPOs and SPs.

Focussing on rehabilitation aspects, the DM called for systematic monitoring of registered drug addicts. "Regular assessment of improvement and relapse conditions is essential for effective control of drug abuse," he stated, directing officers to maintain detailed statistics of registered cases.

The meeting also raised concerns over the probable abuse of Schedule H drugs - prescription medications that require strict monitoring and can only be dispensed under valid prescriptions. The DM instructed the Assistant Drugs Controller and local police to conduct regular and surprise inspections in their jurisdictions.

A major thrust was given to preventive measures as the District Magistrate outlined the roadmap for declaring Drug-Free Panchayats and Urban Local Bodies. He also stressed on strict implementation of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA) effectively.

SSP Joginder Singh emphasised enhanced inter-departmental coordination and stressed on strict enforcement of law and order to prevent the escalation of drug-related issues in the district.

Strategies were also dis-

cussed regarding taking stringent action against illegal properties linked to drug trafficking, under rules. The meeting delved into educational initiatives, with extensive discussions on awareness programs and identification of drug hotspots in the district. The house also deliberated on mechanisms to monitor

unusual transactions of drugs and other scheduled substances.

The meeting saw participation from senior officers including ADM Ansuya Jamwal, SDMs, SDPOs, Chief Medical Officer, Medical Superintendent Government Psychiatry Hospital besides other committee members.

Notification

Under section 11(1) of RECTLAR & R Act 2013

Whereas, Deputy Inspector General/NZ-II, Central Industrial Security Force vide No. PR-13018/NZ-II/Prov/7THRB/Land/2024/124 dated 13.03.2024 placed a fresh indent for acquisition of 04 no.s of private patches of land measuring **24 Kanal 18 Marlas** falling under Khasra No. **116,243,244 and 245** situated at village Ratwana, Tehsil Ghagwal for the establishment of CISF 7th Reserve Battalion.

Whereas, Indenting Department vide No. PR-13018/NZ-II/Prov/7THRB/Land/2024/167 dated 11.04.2024 placed another indent for acquisition of 05 more private patches of land measuring **37 Kanal 18 Marla** falling under Khasra No. **448,449,450,451 and 452**.

Whereas, Indenting Department vide No. PR-13018/NZ-II/Prov/7THRB/Land/2024/8597 dated 15.05.2024 requested to initiate the acquisition proceedings of 09 no.s of private patches of land having total area of **62 Kanal and 16 Marla**. Further, it was also requested that exemption may be accorded for carrying out Social Impact Assessment study required under section 04 of The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 along with exemption of an additional compensation of 75% of the total compensation under section 40 of the Act.

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Samba vide order no. DCS/LAS/01 of 2024 dated 17.10.2024 under endorsement no. DCS/LAS/24-25/34-35 dated 17.10.2024 exempted Social Impact Assessment Study for 04 patches of private land measuring **24K-18M** along with exemption of an additional compensation of 75% of the total compensation under section 40 of the Act, as the project affects the security and strategic interest of the State/ UT and is related to Defence of India and National Security.

Whereas, Indenting Department vide No. PR-13018/NZ-II/Prov./7TH RB/Land/2024/594 dated 07.11.2024 requested for exemption to undertake SIA study for acquisition of remaining 05 patches of private land measuring **37K-18M**.

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Samba vide order no. DCS/LAS/03 of 2024 dated 13.12.2024 under endorsement no. DCS/LAS/24-25/46-47 dated 13.12.2024 exempted Social Impact Assessment Study for remaining 05 patches of private land measuring **37K-18M** along with exemption of an additional compensation of 75% of the total compensation under section 40 of the Act.

In exercise of powers vested in me under **Section 11 (1)** of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013, I, Sunaina Saini, JKAS, Collector Land Acquisition, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ghagwal do hereby notify that the land whose particulars are given herein below is required for establishment of CISF 7th Reserve Battalion.

Further, under **Section 11(4)** of the Act no person shall make any transaction or cause any transaction of land i.e. sale/purchase etc. or creates any encumbrance on such land from the date of publication of this notification without prior approval of the Collector.

Objections to the acquisition if any, may be filed by the person(s) interested within 60 days from the date of publication of notification under Section 15 of the Act before the Collector Land Acquisition, Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ghagwal.

Any objection statement which is received after the due date or which does not clearly explain the nature of the senders interested in the land is liable to be summarily rejected.

Objections received within the due date if any, will be enquired into where the objectors will be at liberty to appear in person or by advocate and to adduce any oral or documentary evidence in support of their objections.
