## Protest against CEO Municipal Council Udhampur enters Day 3

**STATE TIMES NEWS**  
UDHAMPUR: The protest led by locals and volunteers of Dogra Kranti Dal (NGO) against the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Municipal Council Udhampur has entered its third consecutive day also burnt effigy, with mounting anger over alleged harassment of poor street vendors and daily wage earners. While leading the protest Vishal Singh (Executive Member) Protesters have accused the CEO of forcibly seizing the rebhis (carts) and goods of small vendors, depriving them of their livelihood. "The CEO is harassing the poor and

snatching away their means of survival. Their carts and belongings have been taken without any prior notice, leaving them helpless," said a spokesperson for Dogra Kranti Dal. The demonstrators condemned the municipal action, calling it unjust and inhumane, especially towards economically weaker sections of society. They demanded the immediate transfer of the CEO, holding him responsible for the deteriorating condition of street vendors and small traders in the town. Chanting slogans, the protesters vowed to continue their peaceful agitation until justice is served and the

CEO is removed from his position. They have also urged the Deputy Commissioner of Udhampur to intervene and ensure that the seized goods are returned to the affected individuals without delay. Pawan Singh (Local resident) emphasized the importance of safeguarding the rights of the underprivileged and warned of intensified protests if their demands are not met promptly. The protest continues to draw widespread support from the local community, with residents standing in solidarity with those affected.
