**A. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF SAHAYIKAS (ANGANWADI HELPERS)**

- The selection of Sahayikas shall be restricted to the electoral ward where Anganwadi centre is located.
- Women candidates in the age group of 18-37 years as on 01-01-2024 shall be considered for the post.
- The candidate shall be a domicile of the UT of J&K.
- The selection of Sahayikas shall be restricted to the electoral ward where Anganwadi Centre is located.
- Minimum qualification for Sahayikas (Anganwadi Helper) shall be Matriculation.
- In case no matriculation candidate is available in the ward, Candidate with qualification not less than 8th standard shall be considered.
