

6 dumpers seized for illegal mining

SAMBA/JAMMU: Continuing its drive against illegal mining, Samba Police has seized five dumpers in the jurisdiction of Police Stations Samba and Ghagwal which were being used for illegal transportation/mining of the construction material. Police teams headed by SHO PS Ghagwal, Incharge of Police Posts Supwal & Mansar of PS Samba and Incharge Police Post Rajpura of PS Ghagwal while performing patrolling duty in their jurisdictional areas, have seized five dumpers bearing registration Nos. JK21C-2988, JK02CG-2974, JK21G-6049, JK21D-9880, JK21G-7597 which were being used for illegal transportation/mining of the construction material in the area. The above-mentioned vehicles have been seized by Samba Police and handed over to the Geology & Mining Department, Samba for further legal action. As part of its sustained drive against illegal mining activities under operation Ploughing, Jammu Police, South Zone has taken action against unlawful transportation of mining material in the Gangwal area. A police team from Police Station Gangyal intercepted and detained one dumper bearing registration number JK21J-9580, which was found involved in the illegal transportation of mining material without any valid authorization or permit. The vehicle was detained on the spot for further legal proceedings. The matter has been brought to the notice of the DMO Jammu, for initiation of necessary action under the relevant provisions of law.

Property worth Rs 46.48 lakh of notorious drug peddler attached

SAMBA: As a part of its relentless effort against drug peddlers/smugglers, Samba Police has attached a residential house and an alto car bearing registration number JK02CR-3823 valuing approximately 46.48 lacs belonging to notorious drug peddler Wali Mohd S/o Lal Hussain R/o Chak Murara tehsil Bishnah district Jammu, presently residing at Balole Khad Bari Brahmana district Samba. The action was taken by Police under sections 68-E read with 68-F of NDPS Act of 1985 and is linked with case FIR No.173/2025 u/s 8/21/22/25/29 NDPS Act of PS Bari Brahmana. The residential house valuing rupees 42.86 lacs approximately and the car valuing rupees 3,62,293.00, making a total of rupees 46,48,293.00, were identified as illegally acquired property during the course of investigation/enquiry conducted by police. The property was prima facie acquired from illicit trafficking in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances by the drug peddler. It is pertinent to mention here that the accused Wali Mohd is involved in assault on Police Party at Balole Khad Bari Brahmana and in this regard a case FIR No. 36/2025 has been registered against him at PS Bari Brahmana. The said accused is also an associate of notorious drug peddler Masoom Ali @ Kala S/o Dulla R/o Rakh Barotian tehsil Vijaypur district Samba against whom various NDPS cases have been registered in the district.

UDHAMPUR: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking, Udhampur Police, while performing routine patrolling duty at Housing Colony, Udhampur, apprehended two persons and recovered heroin from their possession.

During personal search, the police party recovered 2.53 grams of heroin from Anjad Hussain S/o Manzoor Ahmed R/o Housing Colony, Udhampur and 1.88 grams of heroin from Milap Chand S/o Bodh Raj R/o Housing Colony, Udhampur totaling 4.41 grams. In this regard, a case FIR No. 424/2025 under Sections 8/21/22 of the NDPS Act has been registered at the Police Station Udhampur and further investigation is underway.

Udhampur Police while performing traffic checking duty at Nakka Motor Shed, Chenani, Police team of PS Chennai led by its SHO intercepted one vehicle (Toyota Fortuner) bearing Registration No. JK01AN 7711 coming from Jammu and heading towards Srinagar and signalled it to stop for checking.

During checking, 4.91 grams of heroin was recovered from the personal possession of the driver Omar Shafi Bhat S/o Mohammad Shafi Bhat R/o Soura, Srinagar. Further, during checking of two other persons travelling in the said vehicle namely Abrar Bashir S/o Bashir Ahmed Sheikh R/o Meerakabad, Shalimar and Eyoen Parvaiz S/o Parvaiz Ahmad Mir R/o Gasoo, Hazratbal, District Srinagar, 4.85 grams and 4.55 grams of heroin were recovered respectively.

In total, 14.31 grams of heroin-like narcotic substance was recovered from all the 03 accused persons.

In this regard, a case FIR No. 133/2025 under Sections 8/21/22 of the NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Chenani and further investigation is underway.

Two missing women traced, reunited with families

DODA: Doda Police have successfully traced a missing lady and reunited her with her family.

On 23.01.2025, a lady namely R/o Charota, Tehsil Assar, went missing from her residence. In this regard, a missing report was lodged at Police Station Assar. On 18.12.2025, with the help of technical assistance and human intelligence, the said missing lady was traced from Bhaderwah. After completing all required legal formalities, the missing report has been closed accordingly, and the lady has been safely reunited with her family. Demonstrating swift response and professional efficiency, Jammu Police, South Zone successfully traced a missing minor girl within a few hours of registration of an FIR at Police Station Baghe Bahu. On December 18, 2025, parents of a minor girl from Bazigar Basti, Baghe Bahu reported at Police Station Baghe Bahu that their daughter had gone missing on December 16, 2025. The parents had made earnest efforts on their own to locate the girl for two days but failed to trace her. They further alleged that their daughter had been kidnapped by some persons from the Akhmoor area.

Taking cognizance of the complaint, Police Station Baghe-e-Bahu registered FIR No. 137/2025 under sections 49 and 137(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) and initiated a thorough investigation. The investigation was taken up by SHO Police Station Baghe Bahu, Inspector Ashwani Kumar, who constituted a dedicated police team and launched an intensive search operation.

Drug peddler nabbed with intoxicating capsules

POONCH: Acting on specific information, District Police Poonch laid a special naka at Fazla-Abad Bridge falling under the jurisdiction of Police Station Surankote. During naka checking, pedestrians were subjected to lawful frisking.

During the course of checking, one pedestrian was put to personal search, which led to the recovery of 08 strips of Tapentadol tablets (total 80 tablets) and 03 strips of Tramadol tablets (total 45 tablets) from his possession.

On questioning, the individual disclosed his identity as Intiaz Ahmed, S/o Shabir Ahmed, R/o Dhra Mohra, Tehsil Surankote, District Poonch. He was apprehended on the spot.

Accordingly, a case FIR No. 294/2025 under Sections 8/20/21 of the NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Surankote, and further investigation is underway to identify the source and network involved in the illegal trafficking of narcotic drugs.
