Dairy Units engaged in sale of milk and milk products through vending/kiosk machines and similar dispensing systems to strengthen food safety compliance

Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) encourages the Food Business Operators (FBOs) engaged in the sale of milk and milk products through temporary or fixed vending machines, kiosks, and similar dispensing systems to adopt measures to achieve an appropriate level of protection of human life and health and the protection of consumer's interests, including fair practices in all kinds of food trade with reference to food safety standards and practices.

In order to curb adulteration in milk and milk products in the country, compliance by dairy manufacturers involved in sale of packaged/fresh milk & milk products through such manual/ automated dispensing systems becomes crucial for ensuring safety, quality and standard of dairy products. Accordingly, FSSAI has issued an directives to all dairy manufacturers who are involved in sale of milk/milk products through vending/kiosk machine to keep make available; FSSAI-approved/validated rapid test kits at the vending/kiosk location for basic detection of common adulterants in milk/milk products, so as to ensure food safety, consumer confidence & interests, transparency and to encourage participatory food safety culture in the country.

Further, the concerned dairy units shall;

1. Display simple instructions on "How to Use the Rapid Test Kit".

2. Facilitate consumer self-checking, by either:


- Allowing consumers to use kits at the kiosk area, Or
- Keeping the kits for demonstration by trained staff.

3. Ensure that kits used are within validity period and stored as per manufacturer's guidelines.

4. Monitor and Keep a record of results and utilization of such testing kits.

The Caveator respectfully submits as under:-

1. That the caveator is the owner in possession of land measuring 17 marlas comprising under khata no. 1075 min. and khawat no.23 situated at revenue village: Paloura, Tehsil Jammu North and District Jammu. Copy of sale deed is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-A

2. That the Caveator apprehend that the non-caveators may file a suit alongwith an application for interim relief before this Honble Court.

2. FOR ADMISSION, FOLLOWING WILL BE THE MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY:

A MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO TWO YEAR PG PROGRAMMES (EXCEPT FOR LL.B):
For the candidates (except SC/ST categories), the minimum eligibility is 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination as per the Program -Specific Eligibility. In case of SC/ST the minimum eligibility is 45% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination as per the Program -Specific Eligibility. For LL.B, the candidates must have 45% of marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination and 40% in case of SC/ST candidates.
B MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO ONE YEAR PG PROGRAMMES:
Candidate seeking admission to the One Year PG Programme must have passed 4 Years bachelor degree examination and have earned 50% of Credits in the subject in UG program under NEP-2020 (45% in case of SC/ST)

FIRST PREFERENCE (CUET & Major Subject)	CUET-PG-2026 or CUET-UG-2026 + Programme Specific Eligibility. NOTE: To be eligible for admission applicant must have scored minimum 40 Marks in a particular paper of CUET-PG-2026
SECOND PREFERENCE (JUET & Major Subject)	For 2 Years PG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 70% of Academic Merit and 30% of JUET-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility. For 1 Year PG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 50% of Academic Merit and 50% of JUET-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility For Integrated UG-PG/UG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 70% of Academic Merit and 30% of JUET-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility

4. Provisional admission to 2 Year/ 1 Year PG Programme shall be made on the basis of the qualifying examination upto Semester 5th / 7th as the case may be. However, provisional admission to a particular programme shall be confirmed after passing of the 6th/ 8th Semester of UG programme.
