Sam Pitroda exposes Congress' global nexus, Rahul part of Anti-India Alliance: Gaurav

JAMMU: BJP Spokesperson and Convener for International Affairs Gaurav Gupta intensified its attack on the Congress. alleging that senior leader Sam Pitroda has inadvertently exposed the party's alleged links with what it termed as "anti-India global forces," triggering a fresh political storm over Rahul Gandhi's foreign engagements. Issuing a statement, Gauray Gupta said that Rahul Gandhi's repeated foreign visits and remarks critical of India have long raised concerns, but Sam Pitroda's recent comments have now provided what he described as a "clear admission" from within the Congress ecosystem itself. Gupta asserted that Pitroda, regarded as Rahul Gandhi's family advisor and a key ideological influence, revealed that the Congress is part of the Global Progressive Alliance (GPA) and that Rahul Gandhi attended a conference in Germany under this platform.According to Gupta, Pitroda went further to state that Rahul Gandhi is a member of the presidium of the Global Progressive Alliance, while Pitroda himself is a member: "This means Rahul Gandhi holds a leadership position in a global political alliance whose activities and affiliations raise serious questions," Gupta

Rahul Gandhi's meetings during his foreign visits, including his interaction with Cornelia Woll, a member of the presidium of the Central European University, an institution funded by George Soros' Open Society Foundation. He said this meeting, coupled with Pitroda's admissions, points to a larger pattern of association with global entities that have been critical of India's democratic institutions and policies.

Calling it a matter of national concern, Gupta said the Congress must explain whether it has become part of a "nefarious nexus of global forces working to undermine India's interests." He stressed that these were no longer allegations made by the BJP but statements made by Sam Pitroda himself, who has been associated with the Gandhi family for decades and is widely seen as an architect of Rahul Gandhi's ideological worldview. Gupta said that Rahul Gandhi's habit of raising internal political issues on foreign soil and aligning with international platforms that question India's sovereignty and democratic processes cannot be brushed aside as coincidence. ' The BJP reiterated its demand for a clear and categorical response from the Congress and Rahul Gandhi on their association with the

Veteran Journalist mesmerizes audience with recollections of Vajpayee at Atal Smriti Vyakhyan Mala

DEHRADUN: Renowned journalist and thinker Pradeep Sardana enthralled the audience with his insightful and emotionally rich recollections of Bharat Ratna and former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vaipayee during the prestigious Atal Smriti Vyakhyan Mala. The event was graced by Uttarakhand Governor Lt. Gen. Gurmeet Singh as the Chief Guest, while Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami attended as the Distinguished Guest. The lecture series was organized by Lekhak Gaon under the patronage of former Union Education Minister and former Chief Minister of Uttarakhand. Ramesh Pokhriyal "Nishank," and its Director, Vidushi "Nishank." The programme drew a distinguished audience of writers, intellectuals, journal-

ists and admirers of Atal ii's legacy. Delivering the keynote address, Pradeep Sardana shared several lesser-known anecdotes from Atal Bihari Vajpayee's life that reflected his humanism, foresight, and philosophical depth. Quoting Atal ji, Sardana remarked, "A person may be beaten but should never be denied the right to cry. And success in life does not come from memorizing things, but from internalizing them." These thoughts, he said, shaped Vajpayee's approach to politics and life. Recalling a significant political moment, Sardana said that in April 1995, when P.V. Narasimha Rao was Prime Minister and L.K. Advani had emerged as a mass leader after the Ram Mandir Rath Yatra, it seemed unthinkable that Vajpayee

would become Prime Minister.

Yet, Sardana predicted exactly

that in the cover story of his newspaper Punarvas. When Delhi's then Chief Minister Madan Lal Khurana released the issue, he jokingly remarked, "If this comes true, to aapke mooh mein ghee shakkar. Sardana later sent the issue to Vajpayee, who responded with a letter expressing disbelief. Remarkably, exactly a year later, Vajpayee became Prime Minister for the first time.

Sardana also revisited the political upheaval of 1979, when Chaudhary Charan Singh's move led to the fall of Morarji Desai's government. Quoting Vajpayee, he recalled his disappointment, saying that Charan Singh had "stabbed his comrades in the back to hoist the flag at the Red Fort."

The lecture also highlighted Vajpayee's moral upbringinglearning compassion from his grandfather and the value of deep understanding from his mother. Inspired by Atal ji, Ramesh Pokhriyal "Nishank" established Lekhak Gaon in Dehradun. On Vajpayee's birth centenary last year, the Atal Smriti Vyakhyan Mala was launched, and this year marked the second edition of the lecture series, reaffirming Atal ii's enduring intellectual and moral legacy

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH), Government of India, vide Notification G.S.R. 901(E) dated 22.12.2022, has introduced a comprehensive regulatory framework under Rules 55A to 55H of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 for authorization of Dealer Registered Vehicles (DRVs).

The objective of these rules is to ensure standardization of the vehicle resale ecosystem, prevent fraudulent vehicle transactions, strengthen accountability through complete digital traceability on the VAHAN Portal, and to prevent misuse of purchased vehicles by anti-social or anti-national

In this regard, all dealers engaged in the purchase and sale of second-hand / pre-owned vehicles in District Samba are hereby informed to get themselves registered with the ARTO Office, Samba, through online mode on the Dealer Authorization Certificate (DAUC) Portal, within seven (07) days from the date of issuance of this notice.
