Aarav Rastogi invoked Kabir Sen's wisdom, "If you wait for the perfect moment, you will wait forever: Progress begins the moment you do."

Applauding the presenters for a thoughtful and inspiring assembly Principal JKPS Kunjwani Rajesh Rathore said, "Procrastination is not merely a delay of action; it is a silent thief that steals our focus, our growth and our future. Each deferred task forms a chain that binds our potential, yet every small, courageous step we take breaks that chain and sets us on the path of excellence. When we choose action
