FINAL NOTICE

Subject: Unauthorized absence from duties by Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer, PM Package Mechanical & Hospital Division, SKIMS, JVC, Soura.

WHEREAS, Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer (PM Package), Mechanical & Hospital Division, SKIMS/JVC proceeded on ten days Earned Leave w.e.f. 09.12.2024 to 18.12.2024, which was sanctioned by the Executive Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Division, SKIMS-JVC, Soura;

AND WHEREAS, the official sought an extension of the leave which was refused by the concerned Executive Engineer on 19.12.2024 with the clear instructions to resume duties immediately;

AND WHEREAS, the official was informed via email that the Central Heating System at SKIMS, Soura, required uninterrupted technical supervision and the official was required to remain present to ensure seamless functioning of these life-saving services;

AND WHEREAS, a notice was served to the official by the Superintending Engineer, Mechanical and Hospitals Circle Kashmir vide letter No. SEMHK/39/3819 dated 27.01.2025, directing him to resume duty within 15 days. However, the official failed to respond or comply;

AND WHEREAS, the official was issued notice by the Executive Engineer for resumption of duties without full leave vide letter No. MHD/SKIMS/JVC-568-71 dated 05.05.2025, and in response, the official applied through an email requesting for grant of any kind of leave;

AND WHEREAS, a fourth notice was issued by the Executive Engineer vide No. MHD/SKIMS/JVC/684-87 dated 09.05.2025, providing an opportunity to resume duty, which was once again ignored by the said official;

AND WHEREAS, in terms of Rule 31 of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956, Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer, was placed under suspension with immediate effect and attached to the office of the Superintending PWD-NGAZOMECH/14/2025-05-PWD R&B DEPARTMENT I/573682/2025 Engineer, Mechanical and Hospital Circle, Kashmir, vide Order No. SEMHK/Estt-57/92 of 2025 dated 20.06.2025, for unauthorized absence from duties and misconduct on his part;

AND WHEREAS, the Chief Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Directorate, Kashmir vide letter dated 25.06.2025 intimated that Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer (PM Package), has remained unauthorizedly absent from his duties and has been placed under suspension by the Superintending Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Circle, Kashmir, vide Order No. SEMHK/Estt-57/92 of 2025 dated 20.06.2025;

AND WHEREAS, the Chief Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Directorate, Kashmir, conveyed that the official is a habitual absconder with a record of similar misconduct in the past;

AND WHEREAS, the case was examined by the Department and, vide this Department's letter dated 12.08.2025, the Chief Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Directorate, Kashmir was requested to appoint an Inquiry Officer to investigate the matter under Article 128 of the J&K Civil Service Regulations, 1956, and submit a detailed report along with specific recommendations;

AND WHEREAS, the Chief Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Directorate, Kashmir, vide letter dated 11.09.2025, intimated that an Inquiry Committee had been constituted vide Order No. 88 of 2025 dated 14.08.2025 under the Chairmanship of the Superintending Engineer, Mechanical & Hospital Circle, Kashmir;

AND WHEREAS, the Committee conducted a detailed inquiry and submitted its report with the following recommendations:-

"It stands established that Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer (PM Package), has remained on willful unauthorized absence from 19.12.2024 till date (252 days), disobeyed repeated instructions, failed to furnish any valid justification, and has a proven record of similar misconduct in the past".

AND WHEREAS, Rule 25 of J&K Civil Services (Leave) Rules 1979 provides as under:-

Rule 25 - Absence after expiry of leave:-

- Unless the authority competent to grant leave extends the leave of a Government servant who remains absent after the end of leave is entitled to no leave salary for the period of such absence and that period shall be debited against his leave account as though it were half-pay leave, to the extent such leave is due, the period in excess of such leave due being treated as extraordinary leave.
- Willful absence from duty after the expiry of leave renders a Government servant liable to disciplinary action.

Exception 1-Whenever a Government servant is detained on the road owing to its being blocked by land slips, snow etc., he may be treated as, on duty during the period of unavoidable detention, but will be entitled, until he rejoins his appointment, to draw leave allowances.

The above concessions will not apply in cases of overstay of casual leave or quarantine leave such leave not recognized leave.

Exception 2- Whenever a Government servant, on his return from leave (other than casual leave or quarantine leave) is detained owing to cancellation of air flight due to bad weather or otherwise, he may be treated as on duty for the period of unavoidable detention, subject to a maximum of two days. For the period of enforced halt, he will be entitled until he rejoins his appointment, to draw leave allowances only.

AND WHEREAS, Government Instructions (1) below sub-rule 5 of Rule 31 of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956, provide that in case a Government servant has unauthorizedly absented from duty, the proper course is to initiate action against him under Article 128 of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulation;

AND WHEREAS, Article 128 of the Jammu & Kashmir Civil Service Regulation, 1956, provides as under:-

"Absence without leave or after the end of the leave involves loss of appointment".

AND WHEREAS, more than eleven (11) months have passed after expiry of sanctioned leave in favour of Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer (PM Package), however, he has not joined back to date;

NOW THEREFORE, before proceeding ahead in terms of above rules against the absentee, a final opportunity is hereby afforded to Shri Vimilesh Kumar, Junior Engineer (PM Package), through the medium of this final notice/ opportunity of being heard/ compliance, to immediately resume his duties without any further delay and explain his position for remaining un-authorizedly absent from official duties, failing which action under Article 128 of the Jammu & Kashmir Civil Service Regulation, 1956, shall be initiated, without any further notice and in case of failure on his part, the matter shall be decided as exparte.
