Selection Criteria	Army				Navy				Air Force						
Education Qualification	Agniveer (General Duty) (All Arms) & Agniveer (General Duty) (Women Military Police) -Class 10 th Matric pass with 45% marks in aggregate of five basic subjects and min 33% marks in each of those five subjects. For boards following grading system, grades commensurate to percentages, as above, will be considered. Note: Candidates with valid Light Motor Vehicle (LMV) Driving Licence will be given preference for Driver requirements. Agniveer (Technical) (All Arms) -10+2/ Intermediate Exam pass in Science with Physics, Chemistry, Maths and English with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 40% in each subject. OR 10+2/ Intermediate Exam pass in Science with Physics, Chemistry, Maths and English from any recognised State Education Board or Central Education Board to include NIOS and ITI course of minimum one year in required field with NSQF level 4 or above. OR 10 th /Matric pass with 50% in aggregate and minimum 40% in English, Maths and Science with 02 years of Technical training from ITI or two/ three years Diploma from recognised educational institution including Polytechnics in specified streams (Mechanic Motor Vehicle, Mechanic Diesel, Electronic Mechanic, Technician Power Electronic System, Electrician, Fitter, Instrument Mechanic, Draughtsman (all types), Surveyor, Geo Informatics Assistant, Information and Communication Technology System Maintenance, Information Technology, Mechanic cum Operator Electric Communication System, Vessel Navigator, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Auto Mobile Engineering, Computer Science/ Computer Engineering & Instrumentation Technology) as promulgated in Indian Army Recruitment Notification. Agniveer (Clerk/ Store Keeper Technical) - 10+2/ Intermediate Exam Pass in any stream (Arts, Commerce, Science) with 60% marks in aggregate and minimum 50% in each subject. Securing 50% in English and Maths/ Accounts/ Book Keeping in Class 12 th is mandatory. Agniveer Tradesman 10th Pass (All Arms) - Simple 10 th Pass (No stipulation in aggregate percentage but should have scored 33% in five basic subjects). Agniveer Tradesman 8th Pass (All Arms) - Simple 8 th pass (No stipulation in aggregate percentage but should have scored 33% in five basic subjects).				Agniveer (Senior Secondary Recruit) -Qualified in 10+2 with Mathematics and Physics from Boards of School Education recognised by Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, with minimum 50% marks in aggregate. OR Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical/ Electrical/ Automobiles/ Computer Science/ Instrumentation Technology/ Information Technology) from Central, State or UT recognised Polytechnic Institute with 50% marks in aggregate. OR Passed Two years Vocational Course with Non-vocational subject viz, Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognised by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate. Agniveer (Matric Recruit) - Passed Matriculation/ 10 th or equivalent with 50% marks in aggregate from any Govt recognised School/ Board. Agniveer (Matric Recruit Musician) - Passed Matriculation/ 10 th or equivalent with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from any Govt recognised School/ Board.				Science Subjects - Candidates should have passed Intermediate/ 10+2/Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Education Boards recognised by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English. Duration of Services	Four years														
Enrolment in Regular Cadre	On completion of four years of service, based on organisation's requirements and policies promulgated by the respective services. Agniveers will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Armed Forces. These applications will be considered in a centralised manner based on objective criteria including performance during their four-year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific batch of Agniveers will be enrolled in Indian Armed Forces for further re-engagement in regular cadre. Agniveers will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment in to the Govt of India. Selection of the Agniveers for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Govt of India														
Marital Status and Pregnancy	Only unmarried Indian male and female candidates are eligible for enrolment as Agniveer. Candidates will have to give a certificate of being unmarried at the time of enrolment. Agniveers shall not be permitted to marry during their entire tenure of four years in the respective services. A candidate shall be dismissed from service if he/ she marries during his/ her tenure or is found to be already married despite giving certificate of being unmarried. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such women Agniveer on becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be liable to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will debar the women Agniveer for selection into regular cadre. Note (For Women Military Police in Indian Army only) - Women who are widowed, divorced or legally separated are also eligible provided they do not have any children. Widows of Defence Personnel are eligible with children if they have not remarried.														
Medical Standards	Candidates will be required to undergo medical examination as prescribed by the respective Services. More details available on websites of the respective Services.														
Pay, Allowances, Allied Benefits and Agniveer Corpus Fund (Seva Nidhi Package)	Agniveers enrolled under this scheme will be paid an Agniveer package of Rs. 30,000/- per month with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances, Dress and Travel allowances will be paid. Perks such as ration, clothing, accommodation and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) shall also be provided as per the existing rules. Agniveers shall be given a one-time Seva Nidhi package comprising their monthly contribution along with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below.

Life Insurance Cover	Agniveer will be provided non-contributory Life Insurance Cover of Rs. 48 Lakh for the duration of their engagement period.														
Death Compensation	In addition to insurance cover of Rs. 48 Lakh, one-time ex-gratia of Rs. 44 Lakh for death attributable to service, will be provided to the NOK.														
Disability Compensation	One-time ex-gratia of Rs. 44/25/15 Lakh based on % of disability (100%/75%/50%) shall be applicable to Agniveers.														
Leave	30 days leave per year shall be applicable for Agniveers. Additionally, sick leave would be applicable based on medical advice of competent medical authority.														
Medical and CSD Facilities	For the duration of their engagement period in the Indian Armed Forces, Agniveers will be entitled for medical facility at Service hospital as well as CSD provisions.
