JAMMU: Two-day training programme on production of Quality Spawn for Mushroom Cultivation was held on Wednesday at Mushroom Unit, SKUAST-J here under the aegis of State Agricultural Management and Extension Training Institute (SAMETI).

The training programme was held for the officers of the Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. S.K. Gupta, Director Extension, SKUAST-Jammu and Director SAMETI.

The trainees were given hands-on training on various

aspects of quality spawn production of different mushrooms.

During the training programme special lectures and practical sessions were held on media and substrate preparation for spawn pro-

duction. The participants were exposed to the technical advancements in the field of spawn production like liquid spawn. Interactive sessions were held between the experts and the participants in which the participants clarified their doubts on the quality parameters of spawn and the practical problems that they encounter in spawn production. The training programme was coordinated by Dr. Sachin Gupta, Associate Professor and Course Coordinator under the guidance and convenorship of Prof. Amritpal Vaid, Head, Division of Plant Pathology. The participants of the training programme expressed great satisfaction and hoped for early establishment of more spawn production laboratories in the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir so that the dependency of mushroom growers on spawn laboratories of other states is reduced.

SRINAGAR: Chief Secretary, Dr. Arun Kumar Mehta on Wednesday interacted with representatives of Federation Chamber of Industries Kashmir (FCIK), who called on him here at Civil Secretariat.

During a marathon interaction, a range of vital issues pertaining to the industrial sector were discussed in detail.

Principal Secretary, Industries and Commerce (I&C), Ranjan Prakash Thakur; Director I&C, Kashmir, Mahmood Ahmad Shah and other officers of I&C department also participated in the interaction both in person and through video conferencing.

The representatives of FCIK sought devising a local purchase policy mandating procurement by the government departments from local MSME units to enable them to survive in the market. They also demanded clearance of payments pending with the government departments as well as allotment of land to all those bonafide prospective entrepreneurs, who applied for the same as per the parameters prescribed by the government. They also demanded exemption of Bat manufacturers and Pencil makers from SRO-103, besides ease of some clauses in tendering procedure for industrial unit holders of J&K.

Regarding the issue of delay in payments, the Chief Secretary highlighted that with the introduction of e-tendering, BEAMS and PaySys, the delay of payments within government departments has been reduced to a large extent.

Dr. Mehta advised the representatives to make use of different digital platforms of the J&K government launched recently for better service delivery both to the public and business community.

While deliberating on other issues raised by the FCIK representatives, the Chief Secretary assured them that all their genuine demands will be looked into and resolved on priority.


LG greets people on Guru Ravidas Jayanti
