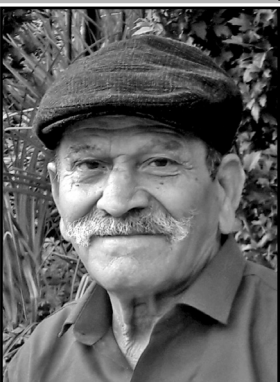

# CRIME REPORT

## Abortive bid to loot JK Bank branch Chittergull

SRINAGAR: A burglary attempt was made at Jammu and Kashmir Branch Chittergull in Anantnag district on Thursday night, said a police official.

As per details, employees of J&K branch Chittergull on reaching the branch spotted that the rear wall of building has been broken. They immediately informed police, which has started the investigation into the matter. Police has said that it was an attempt to loot branch, but burglars failed in their attempt. A case has been registered and investigations are underway.

## Woman found hanging, parents cry foul

MIRAN SAHIB: A woman was found hanging in her house at Maraliyan village on Friday; however her family members have alleged it as murder by her in-laws.

As per details, one Sushma Devi, wife of Vimal Lakhotra, resident of Maraliyan was found hanging in her room after which her family members informed police, which shifted the body to morgue for autopsy. Irked over death of woman, her maternal parents reached spot and alleged it as murder. Victim's mother Ratna Devi and brother Rajinder Kumar alleged thatt Sushma has been killed by her husband as he quite often used to beat her under influence of liquor. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

## Two burglars arrested, stolen property worth Rs 9 lakh recovered

RS PURA: Police on Friday solved many cases of burglary, purse snatching, theft and arrested two notorious thieves involved in multiple cases.

It is pertinent to mention that some theft and burglary cases occurred in R S Pura and subsequently three different FIRs viz No 18/2022 under sections 457/380/511 of IPC in attempt of burglary at JK Bank Badyal Brahmana, No 17/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC for burglary at Chohalla and No 15/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC for burglary at Kotli Shah Doula and FIR No 16/2022 under sections 382 of IPC for snatching, were registered at Police Station R S Pura and investigation started. Special police teams under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Shabir Khan were constituted. The team led by SHO R S Pura Insp Jai Pal Sharma took various digital foot-prints and after proper analysis, arrested two thieves namely Mohd Saleem, son of Mohd Munshi and Sunny Kumar alias Kaka, son of Narinder Kumar, both residents of R S Pura. During sustained questioning, accused confessed their involvement in aforementioned cases and on their disclosures stolen property worth Rs 9,00,000 was recovered from them. The whole operation was conducted under the overall supervision of SP Headquarters Jammu Rammish Gupta.



## Three missing woman traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Friday traced three missing woman and reunited them with their families.

As per details, two complaints were lodged at Police station R S Pura and Bishnah in the jurisdiction of sub division R S Pura, by legal heirs of missing women stating that they went missing from their homes. On this special police teams were formed under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Shabir Khan. The team led by SHO RS Pura Insp Jai Pal Sharma, SHO Bishnah Insp Vinod Kumar assisted by PSI Waseem Bhatti, after hectic efforts and traced a woman from Punjab while other

was traced from Jammu. Subsequently, families of missing women were informed and they were handed-over to their family members after completing all legal formalities.

Similarly a missing report was lodged at Police Post Sarwal by husband of a missing woman stating that his wife went missing from home. On this, a missing report vide DDR No 18 dated August 3, 2021 was registered and investigation started. After this special police teams of Police Post Sarwal led by Incharge Police Post Sarwal PSI Satyajeet Singh, after putting in strenuous efforts, traced the missing woman. Family members of the woman were informed and she was handed over to them after completing all the legal formalities.

## Three theft cases solved; 2 accused arrested

JAMMU: Police on Friday solved three theft cases by arresting 2 accused persons.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Janipur regarding theft and FIR No. 131/2021 under sections 457/380 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team from Police Station Janipur under the supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar led by SHO Janipur Inspr Ajaz Haider assisted by PSI Anil Kumar, after putting in strenuous efforts, nabbed an accused namely Shubam, son of Late Satish Kumar, resident of 319, Gurha Qasim, Bakshi Nagar at present Subash Nagar, Jammu. During sustained questioning, he confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure 4 Tollas of stolen gold ornaments were recovered, including a gold chain and lock-et; two gold rings and a pair of studs.

Meanwhile, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Chatha by one Jaspal Singh, resident of Govindpuri Chatha stating that he along with his family went out at about 2:30 PM to attend a marriage ceremony, but when they returned, they found some cash stolen. On this cognizance was taken by Police Post Chatha and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Chatha under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by Incharge Police Post Chatha SI Ranjit Singh assisted by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani rounded-up two suspects (juveniles). On their disclosure stolen cash amounting to Rs 2,63,200 was recovered.

Similarly, another complaint was received from Anmol Gupta, daughter of Nand Kishore, resident of Digiana stating that she went for her exam in DDE, University of Jammu but when she came back, her i-phone 12 pro max (costing approximately Rs 1.30 lakh) was missing. On this, FIR no 36/2022 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar led by SHO Gandhi Nagar Insp Pankaj Sharma did strenuous efforts and with help of CCTV footages of the area, rounded up a suspect namely Jatin Sharma, son of Late Udhey Kumar. During questioning accused confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure, stolen phone was also recovered from him.

## Two absconders evading arrest since long nabbed

R S PURA: Police on Friday nabbed two absconders, evading arrest since long.

As per details, two absconders namely Nazir, son of Shafi, resident of Kadyal R S Pura and Milkha, son of Amru, resident of Gahti, Kathua wanted in FIR No 91/2020 registered at Police Station R S Pura and FIR No 46/1996 under sections 457/380 of IPC registered at Police Station Bishnah respectively, were arrested by police teams of Sub-Division R S Pura, Jammu.

The teams were led by SHO R S Pura Insp Jai Pal Sharma and SHO Bishnah Insp Vinod Kumar under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Shabir Khan. It is pertinent to mention that a warrant under section 512 of CrPc was registered against the accused, who would be produced in the court of magistrates.

Minor girl injured in landmine blast in Poonch

Poonch: A 12-year-old girl got injured in a landmine blast while grazing goats in Poonch district on Friday.

As per details, a girl namely Jamida Bee, daughter of Muneer Hussain, resident

of Mohd Sokar, Bagyaldara, received injuries on her right shoulder and abdomen in a landmine blast. She was immediately shifted to district hospital Poonch, where she is under treatment.

## Man arrested with 130 intoxicating capsules

KISHTWAR: Police on Friday nabbed a man and recovered 13 strips of intoxicating capsules from his possession.

As per details, during surprise Naka at Wasserkund, Kishtwar Police led by Insp Abid Bukhari along with his team under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Kishtwar Satish Kumar intercepted a pedestrian on suspicion. On checking, banned psychotropic capsules 13 strips (130 Tablets) were recovered from his possession. The accused, identified as Adil Hussain Bagwan, son of Sajjad Hussain, resident of Wasserkund Kishtwar, was arrested and FIR No. 30/2022 under relevant sections of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Kishtwar.
