RAJOURI: A one day awareness and training Programme on Fodder Production, Utilization and Conservation was organised on Saturday here at village Mankote.

The event was organized by IGFRRI RRS Srinagar in collaboration with Regional Agriculture Research Station Rajouri of Sher e Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology Jammu.

The village is mostly inhabited by Gujjars and Bakarwals-the pastorals whose main occupation is rearing various kinds of livestock including cattle, buffaloes, goat and sheep.
