

Comm Secy reviews RDD schemes, assesses functioning of PRIs in Kathua

KATHUA: Commissioner Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Mandeep Kaur, reviewed progress on implementation of ongoing schemes of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj department during a meeting held on Tuesday.

The meeting was attended by Chairman, District Development Council Kathua, Mahan Singh, Deputy Commissioner, Kathua, Rahul Yadav, Mission Director JKRLM, Dr. Sehrish Asgar, Director Rural Development Department Jammu, Mohammad Mumtaz Ali, DDC members, BDCs Chairmen, BDOs and other concerned officers.

Detailed deliberation was held on various issues pertaining to Human Resource Status, UT Capex Budget, PMAY (G), MGNREGA, Swachh Bharat Mission (G), RGSA, 14th FC, IWMP, Umeed, Himayat and other departmental schemes.

While reviewing the available human resources in the district, Commissioner Secretary assured that efforts would be made to fill up vacancies of BDOs and JEs within the shortest time.

Commissioner Secretary discussed in detail the availability of block wise funds and their utilization, so far. She directed the BDOs to follow proper

process of allotment of works so that development works are not hampered on this account. She asked for consultation with all the BDCs, DDCs and PRIs for identification of works in their respective areas.

Regarding provision of offices of DDC and BDCs, Commissioner Secretary directed the Deputy Commissioner for preparing DPR in this regard.

Taking serious notice of slow pace of progress on ongoing works, Commissioner Secretary asked for completion of works within stipulated time ensuring high quality standards. She asked the officers for uploading details of completed works on the departmental portal for information of the concerned.

While discussing initiative of reviving the rural heritage, she impressed upon the concerned officers to identify two heritage works in their respective areas so that the traditional and cultural identity could be projected which in turn will help in their preservation and protection.

KISHTWAR: On the second day of a two day tour to district Kishtwar, Divisional Commissioner Jammu, Dr Raghav Langer and Additional Director General of Police (ADGP), Mukesh Singh visited the snow bound Warwan Valley and took firsthand appraisal of the basic amenities available to the people of the area amid the harsh winter season. The visiting officers also listened and redressed the grievances of the local people.

Besides he asked the PRIs to extend full support and cooperation to the administration to facilitate smooth execution of developmental works in this far flung area. The Div Com assured the public of Inshan that Lieutenant Governor's administration is fully committed and sensitised towards public grievance redressal of remotest areas of the UT.

Later, the Div Com, along with ADGP, interacted with the PRI members and the local and listened to their grievances and demands.

The locals demanded tunnel connectivity from Matti Gowran to Warwan, enhancement of ration quota per family, timely payment of MGNREGA wages, chopper facility to the valley throughout the year, strengthening of health infrastructure and patient care, up-gradation of Educational Infrastructure and expansion of road connectivity, besides posting of full fledged BDO.

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Regarding the issue of stalled projects, she asked the concerned officers for immediate resolution of disputes with the intervention of PRIs. Commissioner Secretary emphasised on conduct of exposure visits, capacity building and training for PRIs for better comprehension of works, schemes and policies with regard to rural development.

While stressing upon the need for better coordination and information dissemination, Commissioner Secretary informed that all panchayat ghars shall be provided internet connectivity through Bharat

Net in coming days.

Reviewing Mahatma Gandhi NREGA, she directed BDOs to update the data related to completed works on MIS portal within a week's time. She exhorted upon the ACD and BDOs to take up works under Swachh Bharat Abhiyan besides identifying beneficiaries and under SBM(G), IHHL with the help of PRIs. She also called for expediting works under Back to Village, IWMP, UMEED and BAPD with active participation of all stakeholders.

Earlier, a detailed resume of progress on ongoing schemes was presented through a PowerPoint presentation. Besides, discussions were also held on financial and physical achievements, availability of funds, non convergence works, convergence works, pending liability and related issues. Meanwhile, Commissioner Secretary also listened to the issues raised by DDC, BDCs and PRIs assuring immediate resolution of the same.

Whereas, the scheme envisages Rs. 5.5 Lakh of financial assistance to each family; and



Whereas, the scheme has been extended from time to time and whereas, as per notice issued by department of DMRRR vide No. DMRRR-ER/76/2021, dated 24.01.2022, the Government has decided to bring the scheme to a closure; and

Now, therefore, through the medium of this notice, all the Displaced Persons of PoJK of Chhamb 1965 and 1971 (camp/non-camp) DPs, presently settled in District Jammu, are hereby notified that in view of the impending closure of the scheme, any eligible beneficiary who has not yet filed his/her claim, may submit the same, in the office of respective Tehsildars till 7th February 2022.
