Prof Rajni Kant, Director, College Development Council and Convener of National Science Day celebrations at University of Jammu gave a profile of Dr T P Singh, known for his work in Rational Structure-based drug design and Protein Structure biology and X-ray crystallography. Prof Rajni Kant said that Dr Singh played an active role in development of drug design in fields of Antibacterial therapeutics, tuberculosis, inflammation, cancer and gastro-pathy. The speaker delivered a lecture on topic

'Structure and functions of innate immunity protein and discovery/ design of anti-viral (Sars-COV2) agents'. He explained in detail role of X-ray crystallography in determining the 3d-structure of protein of the immune system. The second session was presided over by Prof Sat Pal Sharma, Department of Chemistry, JU while Dr Jag Paul Sharma, President SIDAVER, Former Director Research, SKUAST Jammu was the speaker and delivered a lecture on topic 'Indian Agriculture (Crop, Horticulture and Animal Sciences): By 2030 and Beyond'.



Newer proactive initiatives proposed and approved by the present dispensation for which the Department of Agriculture extends gratitude.



The role of farmers is highly underrated, but as the saying goes, they are the backbone of the society we live in. The Government of India introduced the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) in the year of 2016 with the primary objective of insuring the farmers and backing them with necessary financial support on the occurrence of a failure of any of the notified crops owing to natural calamities, pests and diseases.

One of the reasons for rising farm distress in India is crop failures and yield losses triggered by vagaries of climate. Moreover, dwindling rainfall fill the farmers' lives with uncertainty. But as the saying goes, they are the backbone of the society we live in. The Government of India introduced the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) in the year of 2016 to mitigate the effects of farm issued like these, the benefits of PMFBY were publicised in the UT which is aimed at shielding farmers from uncertainty through insurance.


As an end to end risk mitigation mechanism for farmers, the scheme extends coverage for the entire cropping cycle from pre-sowing to post-harvest including coverage for losses arising out of prevented sowing and mid-season adversities. Individual farm level losses arising out of localized calamities and post-harvest losses are also covered due to perils such as inundation, cloudburst and natural fire.

Some notable examples of these covers include crop loss claims over Rs. 37 crore in Jammu Division during the Kharif 2017 to Rabi 2018-19.

I request the farmers to take advantage of the scheme and support achieving Aatmanirbhar Kisan.
