Billawaria seeks waiving off enormous electricity dues of domestic consumers

JAMMU: Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) senior leader Baldev Singh Billawaria, in a press conference on Thursday,

appealed to the UT government to completely waive the electricity bill of those domestic consumers whose electricity bill has reached in lakhs.

Billawaria said that if the electricity bill of a common man has become worth lakhs then that common man is not blameworthy but those officers and employees of the electricity department who are responsible, during that tenure the heavy electricity bill was made and they were not recovered.

Billawaria said that a few days ago he visited various areas on this issue and saw

one area where a person is living in a room and his electricity bill has up to Rs 5 lakh while the cost of his room will not be Rs 5 lakh.

He urged the UT government should completely waive the bill of these people rather whatever bill is made before January 2022 should be completely forgiven and these bills should be compensated from those officers and employees who failed to recover it.

Billawaria also criticized the past government of Congress and other political parties in Jammu and Kashmir and said that during its tenure the electricity infrastructure was not strengthened; they have enjoyed the pleasure of power but the bill which remains the suffering of the people those

political parties are also responsible.

He also said that during its tenure people have also seen those days when electricity used to come in Jammu city for one hour and after two hours there was power failure. But now since the central government led by Prime Minister Narendra Bhai Modi came after 2014, the power infrastructure has been strengthened, he added.

He said that people can feel and see the difference in development, which was not seen in the tenure of the previous government.

Billawaria said that after converting the state of Jammu and Kashmir into a UT, various schemes are being introduced for the welfare of the general public.

He said that the way Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha is doing a lot of work for the welfare of the people of Jammu and Kashmir, he is sure that he will definitely look into this matter as well. Ranjit Singh, Abhinandan Sharma, Muklaj Rai were also present in the press conference.
