STORY: Young Adult (YA) writer Tahir Wazir's debut novel turns out to be a career suicide-ish move. However, salvation comes in the form of his second attempt, which becomes a raging success: an unflattering ode to Sant Kabir's 'Raand Saand Seedi Sanyasi'. But, in a world filled with mystics and mysteries, how 'saintly' is the protagonist? And, why are morbid hashtags attached to his name?

REVIEW: What 'Bestseller' does have working in its favour are the actors. Shruti Haasan de-glamms for Meetu Mathur and after a few initial moments of discomfort in front of the camera, her act picks up pace. Similarly, Bajwa drops the melodramatic bits of his on-screen persona after the first two episodes and gets into the skin of Tahir Wazir: the man, the (ego) maniac. Mithoon Chakraborty plays the role of a top cop who should have been given a stronger, more serious role to portray and not the sad daddy jokes-mouthing ACP Pramanik. Perhaps the only other actor who is a misfit in this dark psychological thriller is Satyajeet Dubey as Parth. The young actor's simple appearance and kind eyes doesn't blend well with the personality traits he tries to achieve with his layered role.

'Bestseller' is a moral lecture, and it wants to instill this belief into your system—that there's no 'absolute' truth to any story. The teacher, however, takes a beaten path for its presentation.

Desperately Seeking Shah Rukh

Review: Economist Shrayana Bhattacharya – for research projects investigating women's employment across different sectors – wanted to map out the commonality between women of different classes in India. To do so, she came up with one common question to ask all of them – "Who is your favorite actor?" The answers that she got were more often than common – "Shah Rukh Khan". This question-and-answer ritual became the foundation for Bhattacharya's debut book 'Desperately Seeking Shah Rukh: India's Lonely Young Women and the Search for Intimacy and Independence'.

"Divided by class but united in fandom, they remain steadfast in their search for intimacy, independence, and fun. Embracing Hindi film idol Shah Rukh Khan allows them a small respite from an oppressive culture, a fillip to their fantasies of a friendlier masculinity in Indian men. Most struggle to find the freedom-or income-to follow their favorite actor," reads the book's blurb.

"Bobbing along in this stream of multiple lives for more than a decade from Manju's boredom in 'rurban' Rampur and Gold's anger at having to compete with Western women for male attention in Delhi's nightclubs, to Zahira's break from domestic abuse in Ahmedabad-Bhattacharya gleans the details on what Indian women think about men, money, movies, beauty, helplessness, agency and love.

The book is divided into four segments: the first three tell us stories of elite, middle class, and lower-class women who love "Shah Rukh".
