Div Com Jammu reviews progress on NH 144A; interacts with PRI members

RAJOURI: Divisional Commissioner Jammu, Dr Raghub Langer on Sunday visited Sunderbani subdivision of Rajouri district and took stock of the progress on NH144A here in a meeting of the concerned officers.

Officers who attended the meeting included DC Rajouri, Vikas Kundal; Col KR J Reddy, CDR 31 BRTF; ADC Sunderbani, Vinod Kumar; SE PWD, Nissar Ahmed Pandit; Maj. Manju Nath, OC 58 RCC and Maj. Vivekanand, OC 57 RCC.

While reviewing the progress on the project, the chair was informed that there are a total 8 packages under which the existing road is being upgraded to double lane with extended shoulders. The packages start from Akhnoor and culminate at Poonch.

It was further informed that 40 villages of Rajouri district come in the alignment of the NH144 A, out of which notification for 31 villages have been made, 7 are in old act and notification process for 2 villages is underway.

Issues regarding the execution of works like Pegg marking, assessment of structures, payment of compensation, demolition of structures where payment has been made and mutation issues were also discussed threadbare in the meeting.
