

# Navin inspects wheat sowing at Zero Line

KATHUA: Principal Secretary, Agriculture Production & Farmers Welfare, J&K UT, Navin K Choudhary conducted an extensive tour of Kathua District to inspect the on ground activities being undertaken by Agriculture and allied departments here today. Tara, Director Sheep Husbandry, Krishan Lal, Director Fisheries, Bashir Ahmad Bhat, CAO, in Hirangan sector due to

Kathua, CHO Kathua, CAHO, Kathua besides other senior officers of the agriculture and allied departments.

While inspecting the border wheat sowing on 150 acres of Land at Hirangan sector, Principal Secretary said that the farmers of this area used to keep large acreage of their land uncultivated along the forward line Indo-Pak Border in Hirangan sector due to

cross border firing. He further elucidated that this year due to government policy a serious of collective efforts were put forth by Agriculture Department, Civil Administration, Security Forces (BSF) and farmers to achieve a breakthrough in this respect. As a result farmers came forward and wheat sowing operation was started during Rabi 2021-22 on Zero Line after a period of 19

years. Pertinently additional support of seed, fertilizers and tractors was also made available to the farmers and Cultivation of Wheat on 150 acre of border land was completed involving 35 farmers of village Chandwan, Chak Changi and Londi.

On the occasion, Principal Secretary interacted with border area farmers during which farmers expressed happiness and satisfaction over this initiative by government that enabled them to cultivate their land after long period. Navin Choudhary asserted that we are looking forward to coverage of all area lying vacant beyond fencing at zero line by next cropping season and all help including provision of agri machinery and other inputs will be made available to the farmers on priority basis. Earlier, Principal Secretary inspected the activities undertaken by Woman FPO at village Jandi where he was informed that said FPO comprises of 233 women covering 9 villages is primarily involved in mush-

room cultivation and organic farming. At Horticulture nursery, Vijaypur, Principal Secretary inspected the newly introduced mother date palm nursery there. He inspected the Horticulture Planning & Marketing Mandi at Tapal. Further he also inspected strawberry farm at Haripur and sheep farm at Rajbagh. Meanwhile, while inaugurating the agri products sale centre set up at Chief Agriculture office, Kathua, Principal Secretary said that 279 nutritional SHGs (one in each panchayat) will be linked with this sale centre providing them a platform for direct sale of their products. Navin stressed that need of the hour is to broaden the base of such centers for bringing the right product at the right price for the consumers. He also recommended setting up more such types of sale outlets so that the farmers get better returns and consumers can enjoy fresh and quality vegetables at their doorsteps.

DODA: SSP Doda, Abdul Qayoom paid a visit to Gandoh and held a public meeting with PRIs functionaries/ prominent persons/ elderly people of Changa area to listen their grievance and issues. The meeting was attended by BDC Chairman Changa and other prominent citizens/Ex-Sarpanches/Members panchayat of the area. SDPO Gandoh Shahzada Kabir Matoo, SHO Police Station Gandoh Insp. Vikram Singh and In-Charge Police Post Changa were also present in the meeting.

During the meeting, participants highlighted many demands and issues of the area which includes

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Director JKRLM, Sehrish Asgar, Director Rural Development Department, Mohammad Mumtaz Ali besides DDC members, Block Development Council Chairman, Block Development Officers and other officials attended the meeting.

Reviewing the status of achievements recorded under various schemes of RDD, Commissioner Secretary was informed that 88% works have been completed under District Capex Budget, 99% Adhar Seeding done in MGNREGA, 100% achievement in financial component of PMAY (G) with completion of 97% houses under the scheme, 75% expenditure registered under 14 FC, 336 SHGs were formed under UMEED while 1003 candidates were enrolled under HIMAYAT with company placement of

365 beneficiaries. Commissioner Secretary asked the concerned officers for preparation of sanitization plans with focus on scientific solid and water waste management and biogas generation infrastructure.

Regarding tapping of tourism potential in the district, Commissioner Secretary emphasized the need for up gradation of existing facilities for tourists besides exploring possibilities for promotion and development of virgin tourist destinations. She impressed upon the concerned officers to fully involve the PRIs in identification and development of such sites.

Commissioner Secretary said that disciplinary action would be taken against those who fail to construct houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna after availing the assistance under the scheme. "DDCs and BDCs have responsible role in ensuring timely construction of houses under PMAY(G) in their respective areas", she added.
