CRIME REPORT

War against drugs continues; 2 arrested with 578 intoxicating capsules

KATHUA : In continuation to its War against Drugs, Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal on Thursday recovered approximately 578 intoxicating capsules (marked as SPM-PRX+) and arrested two persons involved in drugs trafficking. As per details, a police team of Police Station Kathua headed by PSI Fida Hussain under supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammi Kumar during patrolling duty in jurisdictional area near Sabzi Mandi Ward-14, Kathua noticed two suspicious persons trying to hide something on seeing police. They were intercepted and asked to stop for checking. On checking of suspects, identified as Navjot Singh, son of Gurdeep Singh and Sourav Sabarwal, son of Jagdish Raj, both residents of Nanak Nagar Jammu, a black polythene was recovered from Navjot Singh containing approximately 309 intoxicating capsules (marked as SPM-PRX+) while 269 intoxicating capsules were recovered from possession of Sourav Sabarwal, totalling to recovery of 578 capsules. Both were arrested on spot and FIR No. 53/2022 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Kathua.

71 bovines rescued

RAMBAN/SAMBA: Police on Thursday foiled various bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 71 bovines. As per details, during intervening night of Feb 2-3, acting on specific inputs of transportation of bovines, different police parties of Police Stations Batote, Chanderkote and Ramban intercepted four vehicles (JK13-2067, HP11-4861, JK03-F-5629 and JK02-AT-0665) which were on their way from Jammu towards Srinagar and after checking, same were found laden with 67 bovines which were rescued. FIR No 30/2022 at Police Station Ramban, FIR No. 12/2022 at Police Station Batote and FIR No. 10 & 11/2022 at Police Station Chanderkote under Sections 188 IPC, 11 PC Act were registered and investigation started.

The overall rescue operation was made by police parties under the command of Insp Sandeep Charak SHO Ramban, Insp Afzal Wani SHO Chanderkote and Insp Ajeet Singh SHO Batote, under supervision of Pardeep Singh Sen, DySP Hqrs Ramban with overall supervision of SSP Ramban, Mohita Sharma.

Meanwhile, acting on reliable information, a party of Police Station Ghagwal laid a surprise check-point near railway Fatak, Ghagwal and during checking signaled to an Auto Load Carrier (JK08J/9553) to stop but driver did not accelerated the vehicle and jumped Naka point. On this, police party started chasing vehicle but before the vehicle was intercepted, the driver managed to flee from the spot taking advantage of darkness leaving vehicle abandoned few metres away from Naka point.

During checking, 4 cattle were found laden inside vehicle which were concealed in a tactful manner beneath sacks of cattle-feed to avoid being noticed by Police. All cattle were rescued and vehicle used for transportation of bovines was also seized on the spot. In this connection, FIR No. 17/2022 under section 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA

Act was registered at Police Station Ghagwal.

2 vehicle-lifters arrested

JAMMU: Police on Thursday solved a theft case by arresting two accused persons.

As per details, a complaint was lodged by one Shabir Ahmed, son of Raaj Ali, resident of Sandhi stating that his auto (JK02CL- 7818) was stolen from Panama Chowk area. In this regard, FIR No 29/2022 under section 379 IPC was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Station Bahu Fort led by SHO Bahu Fort Inspr Nayat Ali under supervision of SDPO City East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari, after putting in strenuous efforts and with help of analysis of CCTV footages of area along with timely human intervention, finally rounded-up two suspects namely Raiz Ahmed, son of Inayat Ali and Rashid Ali alias Kalu, son of Faqir Ali, both residents of Palpard, Raghooda. During sustained questioning, accused confessed their involvement in theft and on their disclosure stolen vehicle was also recovered. Further investigation of the case is going on and more arrests are likely in case.

Theft case solved; 2 nabbed, stolen property recovered

KALAKOTE: Police on Thursday worked out a theft case by arresting two accused involved in crime and recovered stolen property worth lakhs from them. As per details, on January 11, an information was received at Police Station Kalakote that during intervening night of January 10-11, incidents of theft took place at Kali Mata Mandir and a house located at Sair Kalakote, wherein burglars decamped with cash and gold ornaments.

In this connection, FIR 04/2022 was registered at Police Station Kalakote and a Special Investigation Team headed by SHO Deepak Pathania and PSI Amit Radhlay under supervision of SDPO Nowshera Zakir Shaheen Mirza, Addl SP Nowshera Amit Verma was constituted. During investigation, scores of suspects were picked up and put to sustained questioning and on basis of technical and human intelligence, two persons namely Sarfaraz Ahmed (23) alias Kaala, son of Jameel Ahmed and Fiaz Ahmed (21), son of Mohd Sadiq, both residents of village Garat Broh Kalakote were zeroed in, who during sustained questioning, confessed their crime. On their disclosure, stolen items were also recovered which included Gold nose pins-5, Gold ear rings-2, Gold ring, Silver bangles-4, Mangal Sutar and Rs 12,000 in cash. SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam said that a number of theft cases have been worked out in Rajouri district in recent past and accused have been put behind bars.

Two absconders including rape accused arrested
