

JKPSA discusses problems emerged due to continued closure of educational institutions

UDHAMPUR: To discuss the problems emerged for the Private Schools due to the regular closure of educational institutions, a meeting of office bearers of district Udhampur was organized by R.P Sharma District President.

While speaking members said that there are 270 recognized private schools in district Udhampur. Out of 270 private schools, 97 school owners are solely dependent on the private schools. Members present condemned the new budget because government has not allocated different /exclusive fund for the private schools out of 1040 trillion despite the fact they

are the worst sufferer in this pandemic.

They said government is giving slow poison to all those who have small private schools.

General Secretary of JKPSA, Jammu, Ajay Gupta who was a special invitee gave a patient hear-

ing and said to the members that during lockdown overall education system is collapsed. Moreover education has no priority in Jammu & Kashmir although India has become one of 135 countries to make education a fundamental right of every child under RTE Act.

The opportunity of twenty-five percent (25%) reservation for economically disadvantaged communities in admission to Class I in all private schools has not given till date in JK UT. The state and central government under RTE Act is supposed to share financial

burden for the students who will be enrolled in private school. But till date no one has raised the question for admission of poor students in private schools and mode of sharing financial burden by the state and central government. Ajay Gupta demanded immediate reopening of schools in this month for the students who will be fully vaccinated and who fall in the age group of 15 to 18 years for the larger interest of the students and the owners of small private schools.
