It is to inform to all concerned that in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3D of the National Highway Act, 1956 (48 of 1956); and, further in pursuance of sub-Section (2) of section 3D of the said Act, the Central Government declared that the land specified in the said notification No. S.O. 5366(E) dated 23rd December 2021 published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary Part II, Section 3 Sub Section (ii) has vested absolutely in the central Government free from all encumbrances, for building, maintenance, management and operation of Newly proposed Delhi - Ludhiana, Amritsar - Katra Expressway National Highways no. NE-05 in the stretch of land from Km 475.7 to Km 500.6 falling under village Bagla of tehsil Vijaypur in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir.


