Subject: Consideration order in compliance to Hon'ble High Court order dated 20.03.2019 passed in Dr Ashish Kumar Sharma Vs State.

Order

Dated on .02.2022

1. Whereas, the J&K Public Service Commission vide Notification No. 10-PSC (DR-P) of 2017 dated 27.10.2017 invited applications against 05 posts (OM:03; RBA:01; SC:01) of Assistant Professor in the discipline of Applied Math in Higher Education Department.
2. Whereas, the interview of the eligible candidates was conducted on 31.01.2019 and the selection list was issued vide Notice dated 07.03.2019.
3. Whereas one post under OM category, and 01 post under RBA category were filled. However, two posts under OM category could not be filled up as no candidate from the said category achieved the bench mark of 55%. One post under SC category also remained un-filled due to non-availability of candidates.
4. Whereas, the petitioner has failed to achieve the bench mark of 55% as he has scored only **53.79 points**.
5. Whereas, the petitioner aggrieved due to his non-selection approached the Hon'ble High Court and the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 20.03.2019 directed as follows:-

"Meanwhile, respondents are directed not to re-advertise one post of Assistant Professor as was earlier advertised in pursuance of Notification No. 10-PSC (DR-P) of 2017 dated 27.10.2017 and also consider to redraw the merit of the petitioner qua research and publication. Alteration/modification on laying motion.

6. Whereas, as per the available records, the petitioner has been awarded points as per the following breakup:

- Academics = 25.91
- Experience = 03
- NCC = 02
- Sports = 0
- GM = 0
- 04 Research Papers (UGC approved) = 02 marks (@ 0.5 each; maximum 04);
- 10 Research Papers (Non-UGC) = 02 marks (@ 0.25 each; maximum 02);
- 02 books = 02 marks (@ 0.1 for each book; maximum 03);
- 05 book chapters = 1.25 marks (@ 0.25 each; maximum 02);
- 10 National presentations/seminars/conferences = 02 marks (@ 0.25 each; maximum 02);
- 06 International presentations/seminars/conferences = 03 marks (@ 0.5 each; maximum 03);
- Teaching skill = 02
- Viva = 8.63

TOTAL = 53.79 / 100

7. Whereas, as is evident from above, all the Papers/Publications etc submitted by the petitioner have been considered and awarded points as per the J&K Business & Procedure Rules 1980.

8. Whereas, since all the attributes of the petitioner have been fully accounted for as such the petitioner's merit cannot be re-drawn.

Now, therefore, in compliance to Hon'ble High Court order dated 20.03.2019 passed in SWP No. 574/2019 (TA No. 3068/2020) titled Dr Ashish Kumar Sharma Vs UT of J&K, and the facts stated above, the claim of the petitioner has been considered and found devoid of any merit and is therefore rejected.

RWA expresses dismay over apathetic attitude of Corporator, highlights issues

JAMMU: Expressing dismay on the apathetic attitude of local Corporator towards development and welfare of the area, the Roopnagar JDA Housing Welfare Association has highlighted a number of issues being faced by the residents and urged concerned authorities for initiating necessary measures to mitigate the sufferings of local people.
