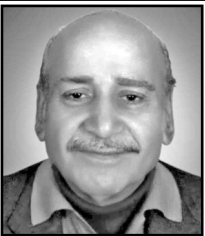

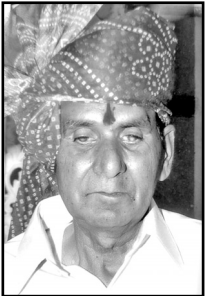

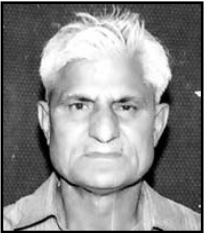

# CRIME REPORT

## Army porter dies of fall

**POONCH:** A 52-year-old porter died after falling from a tree at Banpat sector of Poonch on Monday. As per details, Tarlok Kumar Bali, son of Sunder Dass Bali, resident of Jhulass Poonch was porter with army at Banpat sector Poonch. The body was brought to the District hospital Poonch for medico-legal formalities.

## Two drug peddlers arrested; contraband substances recovered

**GANDERBAL:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs from society, Police in a series of actions have arrested two drug peddlers on Monday and recovered contraband substances from their possession. As per details, officers from Police Post Shadipora at a checkpoint established at Paribal Chundina road intercepted a suspect identified as Bashir Ahmad Malla, son of Mohd Sultan, resident of Tul-Mohalla, Shalabugh. During search, 2 Kg Cannabis powder was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to Police station. In another action, a party from Police Post Nagbal at a checkpoint established at Buserbugh intercepted a vehicle driven by one Irshad Ahmad Khan, son of Samad Khan, resident of Asham Safapora. During checking, 60 gm Charas was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained in custody and vehicle used in the commission of crime was seized. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered at respective police stations and investigations started.

## 7 vehicles seized for illegal mining

**JAMMU:** In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Stations RS Pura, Nagrota and Bagh e Bahu acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 7 different vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles include 4 vehicles including a tractor bearing Chassis No. RK02MDA1266, 2 tractor-trolleys (JK02BH/8682, JK02AN/2989) & a tractor-trolley bearing engine No 475004S22D06085 seized by R S Pura police; a tractor (JK02 9167) and another bearing Chassis No 96188 seized by Nagrota police and a tractor without registration number seized by Bagh-e-Bahu police.

The overall recoveries were made by SHO R S Pura Inspr Jai Pal Sharma, SHO Nagrota Inspr Vishav Pratap Singh and SHO Bagh-e-Bahu Inspr Arjun Singh Chib in their respective jurisdictions. DMO Jammu was also intimated about the same.

## Woman among three absconders arrested

**JAMMU:** Two absconders namely Abdul Karim, son of Mussa Gujjar, resident of Dak Bangla Muraliyan, at present Kansi Peta, Reasi and Maroofa Begum, wife of Mohd Iqbal, resident of Murallian Dak Bungalow at present Pade Bali, Nagrota, who were booked in FIR No 58/07 under sections 341,323,325,382,427 RPC at Police Station Miran Sahib Jammu but were absconding since long, have finally been arrested. Jammu Police was looking for absconders and finally intelligence was generated. Acting on a tip-off, dedicated police teams of Police Station Miran Sahib

constituted under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Shabir Khan and led by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Sultan Mirza, after strenuous efforts, arrested the accused Abdul Karim from Reasi area and Maroofa Begum from Nagrota area. Accused woman was produced before Addl. Magistrate R S Pura while Karim shall be produced tomorrow.

District Police Samba has also apprehended an absconder from Majalta, District Udhampur who was wanted in a case registered at Police Station Samba during 2016.

As per the details, a team of Police Station Samba succeeded in apprehending absconder namely Raj Kumar, son of Munshi Ram, resident of Sonnal Tehsil Majalta District Udhampur wanted in FIR No. 97/2016 under section 380 of RPC registered at Police Station Samba. The accused was evading his arrest since 2016. Accordingly, he was produced in the court of law and sent to District Jail Kathua. Thus, arrest warrant under section 512 of CrPc issued against him got executed.

## Three narco smugglers arrested; heroin, Ganja recovered

**JHAJJAR KOTLI:** Police on Monday nabbed three narco smugglers and recovered 182 gm heroin and 2 Kg Ganja from their possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Jhajjar Kotli constituted under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Inspr Pardeep Kumar and led by SHO Jhajjar Kotli Inspr Devinder Singh during Naka checking near Suketar, rounded up two suspects, later identified as Sadam Hussain, son of Mohd Younas, resident of Lower Munda, at present Kalibari, Tehsil & District Samba and Ali Mohd, son of Doda, resident of Madhara, Samba. On search, 182 gm heroin i.e., 92 gm from Sadam Hussain and 90 gm from Ali Mohd, was recovered.

Duo was arrested and FIR No. 18/2022 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Jhajjar Kotli. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under supervision of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma.

On other hand, at another Naka laid by a team of Police Station Bahu Fort constituted under supervision of SDPO East Zyd Zaheer Abbas Jafari and led by SHO Bahu Fort Inspr Nayat Ali near Railway Station area, police rounded up a suspect, identified as Vinod Pandey, son of Janardhan Pandey, resident of Telwa, Bihar. On search, 2 Kg Ganja was recovered from him. He was arrested and FIR No 38/21 under sections 8/20 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bahu Fort.

## Gambler arrested with Rs 66,200 stake-money

**JAMMU:** Police on Monday arrested a gambler and recovered Rs 66,200 as stake-money from his possession. As per details, a team of Police Post Sidhra headed by Incharge Police Post Sidhra SI Shakil Ahmed while on patrolling duty near Tawi area found some persons indulged in gambling. Acting swiftly, Police caught a gambler along with Rs 66,200 i.e., Rs. 13,200 stake-money and Rs 53,000 from possession of accused along with a deck of playing cards. He was arrested and a case under section 13 of Gambling Act was registered against him at Police Station Nagrota. The accused was identified as Showket Ali, son of Ghulam Ali, resident of Khanpur Nagrota. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar.

## House gutted in Bandipora

**BANDIPORA:** A double-storey house was completely gutted on Monday in a fire incident in Chitтейbandy village of Bandipora district causing huge loss of property.

As per details, fire broke out in two-storey house belonging to Khurshed Ahmad Ganie, son of Gulam Mohd Ganie, resident of Chitтейbandy, Bandipora on Monday early morning, due to which property worth lakhs was reduced into ashes. However timely action of locals and fire tenders doused flames and save other nearby properties. The cause of fire could not be ascertained immediately.

## Old record of FCS&CA Deptt stolen

**JAMMU:** Old record of Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department (FCS&CA) has been stolen from the department's office, located in Ware House area, under suspicious circumstances. As per details, a complaint was lodged on behalf of Mohammad Sagir, Director, Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs at

Ware House Police Post stating that department's record book, cash book, challan book, quota register, dispatch register etc kept in store-quarter no 10 to 11 in Nehru Market, which was 30-year-old record, has been reportedly missing.

According to reports, information was sought from the department regarding the stolen records and based on that, investigation is being carried on. Police is not ruling out role of department's employees in the matter. In view of seriousness of matter, a case of theft of government records was registered at Gandhi Nagar Police Station. Preliminary inquiry has been started and after getting other details, it will be intensified further.

## Nawakadal blaze: One more injured succumbs, toll reaches two

**SRINAGAR:** A 48-year-old man, who sustained severe burn injuries in a fire incident on January 20, 2022 at Jamalata area of Nawakadal Srinagar, succumbed to his injuries on Monday at SMHS hospital, taking toll of deaths to two.

As per details, Abdul Majeed Gujri, son of Ghulam Rasool Gujri, who was undergoing treatment at SMHS since January 20, succumbed to injuries. Majeed and two others sustained severe burn injuries in a massive blaze at Jamalata area of Srinagar, in which four houses were completely gutted and a woman died of burn injuries. However, after battling with life for 18 days, the injured man also succumbed to injuries. The injured had a deep-wound on upper head due to LPG cylinder explosion.
