Ware House Police Post stating that department's record book, cash book, challan book, quota register, dispatch register etc kept in store-quarter no 10 to 11 in Nehru Market, which was 30-year-old record, has been reportedly missing.

According to reports, information was sought from the department regarding the stolen records and based on that, investigation is being carried on. Police is not ruling out role of department's employees in the matter. In view of seriousness of matter, a case of theft of government records was registered at Gandhi Nagar Police Station. Preliminary inquiry has been started and after getting other details, it will be intensified further.

**Nawakadal blaze: One more injured succumbs, toll reaches two****STATE TIMES NEWS**

SRINAGAR: A 48-year-old man, who sustained severe burn injuries in a fire incident on January 20, 2022 at Jamalata area of Nawakadal Srinagar, succumbed to his injuries on Monday at SMHS hospital, taking toll of deaths to two.

As per details, Abdul Majed Gujri, son of Ghulam Rasool Gujri, who was undergoing treatment at SMHS since January 20, succumbed to injuries. Majed and two others sustained severe burn injuries in a massive blaze at Jamalata area of Srinagar, in which four houses were completely gutted and a woman died of burn injuries. However, after battling with life for 18 days, the injured man also succumbed to injuries. The injured had a deep-wound on upper head due to LPG cylinder explosion.

**Youth found hanging****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: A youth was found hanging in his house at Gharota area on Monday.

As per details, 35 years old Ravi Kumar, son of Madan Lal, resident of Karli area of Gharota was found hanging in his room and was shifted to hospital by his parents, where doctors declared him as brought dead.

**Theft case solved, 3 accused arrested****STATE TIMES NEWS**

HIRANAGAR: After solving a theft case in village Radian, Ramgarh police has filed charge-sheet against three accused and sent them to Hiranagar Jail. Police has also recovered jewellery and cash stolen by thieves.

As per details, on January 20, 2022, thieves decamped with gold, silver ornaments and cash from house of one Ram Lal son of Srinivas, resident of Radian village. Accordingly, a written complaint was lodged by victim at Police Station Ramgarh and on basis of that, during investigation police nabbed three accused, who were identified as Prabhat Chand, son of Guke Ram, resident of Ladda Udhampur; Ram Kumar, son of Gopi Chand, resident of Kanthan, Reasi and Jagdish Singh, son of Kasturi Lal, resident of Panasa, Reasi.

These three thieves were presently living on rent in Bari-Brahmana and used to carry out such acts whenever get an opportunity. A case was registered against them at Police Station Ramgarh under sections 457, 380 of IPC.

**Two fraud cases reported****STATE TIMES NEWS**


JAMMU: Two fraud cases were reported in Jammu on Monday. As per details, a man lodged a complaint with Miran Sahib Police that a man duped him of lakhs of rupees on pretext of sending him abroad. He further said that con-man neither sent him abroad nor returned his money back. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

Meanwhile, another man also approached Nowabad Police and lodged complaint that somebody had replaced his ATM card and withdrawn money. Police is investigating the matter.

JAMMU: A doctor was arrested over rape charges on Monday.

As per details, a woman lodged a complaint with Police Women Cell, Jammu that a doctor namely Goldy Khurana, resident of Samba, posted at Kathua hospital has raped her several times. On her complaint, police team nabbed the doctor and started investigation.

**Three narco smugglers arrested; heroin, Ganja recovered****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JHAJJAR KOTLI: Police on Monday nabbed three narco smugglers and recovered 182 gm heroin and 2 Kg Ganja from their possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station JhaJJar Kotli constituted under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Inpr Pardeep Kumar and led by SHO JhaJJar Kotli Inpr Devinder Singh during Naka checking near Suketar, rounded up two suspects, later identified as Sadam Hussain, son of Mohd Younas, resident of Lower Munda, at present Kalibari, Tehsil & District Samba and Ali Mohd, son of Doda, resident of Madhara, Samba. On search, 182 gm heroin i.e., 92 gm from Sadam Hussain and 90 gm from Ali Mohd, was recovered.

Duo was arrested and FIR No. 18/2022 under sections 8/21/22/29 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station JhaJJar Kotli. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under supervision of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma.

On other hand, at another Naka laid by a team of Police Station Bahu Fort constituted under supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari and led by SHO Bahu Fort Inpr Nayat Ali near Railway Station area, police rounded up a suspect, identified as Vinod Pandey, son of Janardhan Pandey, resident of Telwa, Bihar. On search, 2 Kg Ganja was recovered from him. He was arrested and FIR No. 38/21 under sections 8/20 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bahu Fort.

**Gambler arrested with Rs 66,200 stake-money****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: Police on Monday arrested a gambler and recovered Rs 66,200 as stake-money from his possession. As per details, a team of Police Post Sidhra headed by Incharge Police Post Sidhra SI Shahid Ahmed while on patrolling duty near Tawi area found some persons indulged in gambling. Acting swiftly, Police caught a gambler along with Rs 66,200 i.e., Rs. 13,200 stake-money and Rs 53,000 from possession of accused along with a deck of playing cards. He was arrested and a case under section 13 of Gambling Act was registered against him at Police Station Nagrota. The accused was identified as Showket Ali, son of Ghulam Ali, resident of Khanpur Nagrota. The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar.

BANDIPORA: A double-storey house was completely gutted on Monday in a fire incident in Chitteybandy village of Bandipora district causing huge loss of property.



**Old record of FCS&CA Deptt stolen****STATE TIMES NEWS**




