ADH Ramban provides milk van, DG set to budding entrepreneur

RAMBAN: Animal Husbandry Department, Ramban on Tuesday flagged in a newly purchased Milk Van here in the office complex of Chief Animal Husbandry Officer and handed over the same to a budding Dairy Farmer.

According to the Chief Animal Husbandry Officer, Ramban, Dr. Bharat Bushan, the Milk Van has been provided to Mohammad Sadiq, a budding entrepreneur of Sujmatna under Integrated Dairy Development Scheme (IDDS). He said that Sadiq has availed the benefit under the scheme earlier also and established one unit dairy farm of 5 Cows. Now, he has purchased the milk van, DG set under the same scheme by availing the benefit of Rs 2 lakh as subsidy for the milk van and Rs. Rs 0.92 Lakh for DG Set, respectively.

He informed that the Department will also provide him a milking machine under the same scheme with the benefit of Rs. 30000 subsidy.

Out of 50 cows in his dairy farm, four are in milking and 1 is pregnant. On an average his saving makes upto Rs. 40000 per month in spite of being a lean season, the CAHO informed.

On the occasion Sadiq expressed his gratitude to the Department of Animal husbandry Ramban for support and guidance.

Advisory for fruit growers of Jammu Division, February.

The fruit growers of Jammu Division are hereby advised to adopt the following cultural and preventive measures during the month of February 2022 for better management of their orchards.

1. Prune frost damaged twigs.
2. Remove thatching material from young plants if temperature rises.
3. Complete Spring Season Plantation and also provide irrigation to young plants.
4. Use insect traps such as light traps, yellow pan, sticky traps and pheromones to check insect-pests attack.
5. Use Bio-control agents like Trichoderma and Bio-fertilizers such as Azotobacter, Azospyillum, Phosphobacteria, etc to control soil borne diseases and enhance soil fertility.
6. Vermicompost should be added in the soil to enrich, strengthen and increase water holding capacity of soil.
7. If there is scarcity and limited sources of water, micro-irrigation system like Drip/ sprinkler system should be adopted in the orchards.
8. Spray Dimethoate 30EC @ 1ml/litre of water against Leaf Miner, Citrus Psylla and Lemon Butterfly.
9. Spray Copper Oxychloride @ 3gm/litre or Captan @ 2gm/litre of water against Dieback, Anthracnose, Citrus Canker.
10. Spray Dimethoate 30 EC @ 1ml/litre of water against Mango Hopper at panicle emergence stage & against nymphs of Mealy Bugs.
11. Tie alkathene bands 15-20 cm wide around tree trunk at a height of 0.5 m above ground level against Mealy Bug.
12. Spray Copper Oxychloride @ 3gm/litre of water after pruning for the control of Anthracnose in grapes.
13. Apply half dose of Urea in the middle of month.
14. Complete plantation in the new orchards with more than one cultivars in Aonla.
15. Pruning operation Apple and Pear, if not done earlier be got completed followed by application of White Lead Paint to all pruned surfaces.
16. Scrub lichens grown on Apple tree trunks and branches followed by spray of Caustic soda @ 10 gm/litre of water.
17. Dormant spray of TSO (Tree Spray Oil) can be done, if not completed earlier in the ratio of 1:30.
18. Plantation of stone fruit plants be started in already dug out plantation pits.
19. Top working of stone fruit trees particularly against Leaf Curl diseases be got done by applying Copper Fungicide @ 3gm/litre or carbendazim @ 0.5-1.0 gm/litre of water.
20. Pre-Bloom spray on stone fruit trees particularly against Leaf Curl diseases be got done by applying Copper Fungicide @ 3gm/litre or carbendazim @ 0.5-1.0 gm/litre of water.
21. Treat the plants against Gummosis by scraping the diseased portion along with some healthy part with knife & then washing with Mercuric Chloride (1 gm/litre) & applying Bordeaux paste 2:2:30 (Copper sulphate : Lime : Water).
22. Plantation of Walnut / Pecan Nut plants be started in already dug out pits.
