IGNOU extends last date for online admission for January 2024 session till Feb 15

JAMMU: The Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) has extended the deadline for fresh admissions for the January 2024 session until February 15, 2024. Prospective candidates are required to create a User ID and Password on the SAMARTH portal before filling out the admission form online. They should also have a mobile number, email address, properly scanned academic documents, photograph, and means of online payment such as Bank Debit/Credit/Net Banking ready. The admission portal can be accessed through the IGNOU website www.ignou.ac.in or directly via the link https://ignouadmission.samarth.edu.in.

If an online payment made by a learner is not updated immediately, they should refrain from making a second payment right away. Instead, they should wait for a day, check the payment status, and then decide on further actions. It is advisable for learners not to wait until the last date for submission of re-registration forms due to the heavy server load towards the deadline. Regional Director Dr. Jai Prakash Verma emphasized caution during online transactions, recommending learners to use their own card/net banking whenever possible. If learners opt for third-party services (such as cyber cafes or other outlets) for form submission, they must ensure that the courses are selected correctly and the program fee payment is completed successfully. Dr. Jai Prakash urged interested candidates to take advantage of the extended deadline and apply for their desired programs well in advance of the cutoff date.

JAMMU: The National Students' Union of India (NSUI) Jammu Kashmir chapter on Monday launched the "Jai Jawan Movement" against the 'Agnipath Scheme' in Jammu. The Chief Guest of the program was Vikar Rasool Wani, President of JKPC.

Media Dept. Jatin K Raina, and other senior NSUI functionaries. Addressing the gathering, Wani expressed concerns about the implications of the Agnipath scheme, stating that it could adversely affect national security by reducing the number of regular soldiers. He emphasized the importance of maintaining a strong regular force in the armed forces, criticizing the idea of relying on soldiers hired on contract.

He highlighted the ongoing protest of young candidates who cleared examinations but were denied appointment letters, stating that their struggle would continue until justice is served and the Agnipath scheme is revoked.
