

Maintain coordination, synergy of highest level: SSP Kishtwar

KISHTWAR: In a concerted effort to bolster security and intelligence collaboration, SSP Kishtwar, Shri Abdul Qayoom, orchestrated a pivotal Subsidiary Multi-Agency Centre (SMAC) meeting at District Police Headquarters Kishtwar today. ussion was held on the present security situation and other aspects related to security and various suggestions, measures and strategies were taken to put in place for effective and efficient monitoring and security surveillance on ground.

SSP Doda exhorted upon the officers to ensure alertness and vigil in their areas and exercise effective surveillance and monitoring by way of intensifying patrolling, area domination with special focus on suspected /vulnerable areas. The officers were also advised to ensure effective surveillance on social media so that anti-social elements, rumor mongers, mischievous persons may not succeed to create any disturbance to disturb the peaceful atmosphere of the District.

All the officers of District Police and intelligence agencies were advised to work in coordinated and synergized manner so that all the security agencies are on the same page to handle any kind of situation effectively.
