Being part of the wall the staircase is not practically visible but just few steps lead the visitors and devotees to first floor. The temple has huge space to be developed as a heritage site as well as pilgrimage but lack of resources and any attention by the LG government hidden the identity of this unique temple", said Govind Khajuria, member

of temple committee. The temple committee urged the LG administration for starting renovation work soon. A Langer/ Bhandara was organized at temple premises in which locals of the village participated and paid their whole hearted obeisance towards Lord Krishna and seek blessings on this auspicious occasion.
