### Make critical care ambulance movement hassle free in co-ordination with Traffic Department

## Pave way for ambulances carrying patients, or face action: Traffic Police

SRINGAR: The Directorate of Health services Kashmir has issued a circular to the Medical Superintendent of Kashmir division stating that close coordination should be made with the traffic department to ensure uninterrupted movement of ambulance while taking critical care patients to tertiary care hospitals.

According to a circular released by the Directorate of Health Services Kashmir. It has been observed that many ambulances fail to reach their destination on time due to congestion and traffic jams on roads and this sometimes causes major loss of human lives. Apart from this, many questions are raised on the work culture, particularly in the field of co-ordination between health department and traffic authorities.

Directorate made it clear to all MS of Kashmir division that the coordination with the traffic department is maintained at the times when referring Critical care patients for further care or treatment ,which shall result in ensuring priority clearance for ambulances during transit ,avoiding unnecessary delays that could jeopardise patients care, and facilitating smoother traffic flow to expedite emer-

gency responses. Futher, in order to implement the circular instructions , all the medical superintendents of Kashmir division are enjoined upon to follow the following steps:Pre-Approval for Critical cases; before referring a critical patients ensure the approval has been obtained from the traffic department for priority clearance. Real time Communication: Maintain open communication channels with the traffic department to provide updates on ambulance locations and expected arrival times. Alternative Routes: In case of traffic congestion, work with the traffic department to identify and utilize alternative routes for faster ambulance movement. Traing and awareness: Conduct regular training session for ambulance drivers and staff on the importance of coordinating with the traffic department for efficient movement. Feedback



Mechanism: establish a feedback mechanism to receive inputs from ambulance drivers and staff on any issues during transit to be addressed promptly.

Meanwhile, Srinagar Traffic Police on Sunday asked hospital administration and other healthcare centres operating in Kashmir valley to communicate with the department's control room for hassle free movement of patients within municipal limits

of Srinagar. Traffic Police advised commuters to pave way for ambulances carrying patients to referral hospitals, failing which fine of rupees 10,000 and imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months will be invoked under Section 194E Motor Vehicles Act.helpline numbers

"In case of any medical emergency movement, hospital administration and other health care centers operating in Kashmir Valley are advised to communicate with Traffic Police Control Room for hassle free movement of patients within municipal limits of Srinagar. The drivers of the medical emergency vehicles carrying patients and the attendants shall keep close liaison with Traffic Control Unit on helpline numbers during the transit of patient to the hospital for hassle free passage," SSP Srinagar Traffic Police in an advisory said.
