**JAMMU:** The three day awareness program organised by Social Welfare Department under Mission Vatsalya regarding implementation of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection) of Children Act, 2015 and provisions of Mission Vatsalya scheme concluded here on Monday.

The event, held under the supervision of District Child Protection Officer, Mamta Rajput, aimed to enlighten the stakeholders about the schemes under Mission Vatsalya including working of CWC, JJB, children in street situation, child rights, adoption regulations, sponsorship, working of Childline, child care institution and related programs for children.

Earlier, the program was inaugurated by Commissioner Secretary, Social Welfare, Sheetal Nanda, who stressed upon the significance of such trainings in creating awareness and fostering a collective approach among vari-
