CBI has empower to investigate all offences under PC ACT in J&K: HC

JAMMU: Justice Sanjeev Kumar of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court in a landmark judgment holds that CBI has empower to investigate all offences under PC ACT in J&K.

While dismissing the petition of Major General (Retd.) V.K.Sharma and Kiran Sharma, Justice Sanjeev Kumar, observed that it is the plea of the counsel for the petitioners that in case of offence under State Ranbir Penal Code, a fresh consent was accorded by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir in terms of letter dated 18.12.1963 for offences which were notified later by the Central Government under Section 5(1) of the DSPE Act on 01.04.1964 and, therefore, in respect of offence under Section 5(1)(e) of the 2006 Act also a similar fresh consent by the State Government was sine qua non for conferring

jurisdiction and powers on the CBI to investigate the offence. There is no substance in the argument and the same deserves to be rejected. This is so because as is apparent from a reading of the general consent letter dated 07.05.1958, the Government of Jammu & Kashmir had consented to the DSPE/CBI exercising powers and jurisdiction in the State of Jammu & Kashmir for investigation of the specified offences of the State Ranbir Penal Code and not all the offences under the State Ranbir Penal Code and, therefore, if any new offence in the State Ranbir Penal Code was to be added in notification under Section 3 of the DSPE Act, a fresh consent from the Government of Jammu & Kashmir was required. This, however, is not so in the case of offences punishable under the 2006 Act. The State Government's consent for investigation of offences punishable under the

2006 Act is already given vide communication dated 07.05.1958 and as has been explained herein above, once consent is given by the State Government for investigation by the offences punishable under the 2006 Act by the CBI in the territory of Jammu & Kashmir, such consent will hold good for any amendment carried in the 2006 Act and for the new offence(s), if any, created by such amendment(s). To reiterate, the scope of expression "as amended from time to time" cannot be restricted only to the amendments carried out upto 7th May, 1958. The expression has a wider scope and amplitude and, therefore, is required to be construed accordingly, Court ordered.

This significant order has been passed in a petition in which petitioners are the accused facing trial in a criminal case titled Central Bureau of Investigation v. V.K.Sharma

and another before the Court of Special Judge Anti-corruption (CBI Cases), Jammu ["the trial Court"] arising out of FIR No.RC0042014A0001 under Section 5(1)(e) of the Jammu & Kashmir Prevention of Corruption Act, Svt. 2006 ["2006 Act"] read with Section 109-B RPC. They are aggrieved of and have challenged the presentation of criminal challan before the trial Court on the ground that Central Bureau of Investigation ["CBI"], a special police establishment constituted under Section 2 of the Delhi Special Police Establishment Act, 1946 ["DSPE Act"] has no jurisdiction to investigate the offence under Section 5(1)(e) of the 2006 Act unless a prior consent of the State Government in terms of Section 6 is obtained by the CBI. Reliance is placed on Sections 3, 5 and 6 of the DSPE Act to support this contention.

The mela will also feature traditional music and dance performances, adding to the vibrant ambience and celebrating the cultural heritage of Jammu and Kashmir.

Giving details Mission Director JKRLM, Indu Kanwal Chib said that the, SARAS Aajeevika provides a platform for rural women to display their goods and create a market for them to sell their products directly to customers. It also allows them to understand customer preferences and choices, enhance and reinvent their products, and sharpen their marketing abilities.

Apart from the exhibition and sale of products, the SARAS Aajeevika jammu will feature various cultural programs and activities to engage and entertain visitors and measures such as avoiding plastic use and promoting sustainable practices like cloth bags and paper packaging will be encouraged during the mela. Waste management systems will be put in place to ensure cleanliness and hygiene, she said.

She further informed that entry to the fair will be free, and it will be open daily from 10 am to 8:00pm, offering visitors the opportunity to explore around 60 stalls displaying a variety of art and craft. Additionally, a workshop will be organized for women of self-help groups to enhance their marketing skills.

NHW Tapyal, signaled a Scorpio Car bearing regd. No. DL4CNB-5060 coming from Kathua side to stop for checking. But the driver alongwith other unknown accused persons with common criminal intention to kill police personnel on naka duty accelerated the speed, hit with barricade and fled away from the naka point.

The alert police naka party successfully chased the vehicle and intercepted it a few metres away from naka point. During checking of the vehicle, two bovines were found laden inside the Scorpio car which were being transported illegally without any permission.

The notorious bovine smuggler identified as Jamat Ali alias Kalu, son of Siraj Din, resident of Maralian, Miran Sahib tehsil RS Pura district Jammu has been arrested and one 'toka' has also been recovered from his possession.

A case FIR No. 12/2024 U/S 307/188 IPC, 11 PCA Act, 4/25 Arms Act, 3 PDPP Act has been registered at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started.

Similarly in another joint operation by Police Post Rajpura, Border Police Post Babber Nallah and Border Police Post Mawa, two more bovine smuggling bids have been foiled. The vehicle bearing regd. No. PB13BM-8857 loaded with five bovines & vehicle bearing regd No. PB07BX-3253 loaded with four bovines have been intercepted near Madval & Madoon respectively and all the nine bovines have been rescued. However, the drivers of both the vehicles managed to escape from the spot taking advantage of the darkness.

A case FIR No. 13/2024 U/S 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act and case FIR No.14/2024 U/S 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act have been registered at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started.

PCPG meeting held

Dumper seized for illegal mining

Notorious bovine smuggler arrested with sharp edged weapon, 11 bovines rescued

SAMBA: Police on Wednesday arrested one notorious bovine smuggler with sharp-edged weapon, rescued 11 bovines and seized three vehicles including one Scorpio in three separate bovine smuggling attempts during the intervening night of Feb 06/07, 2024 in the jurisdiction of Police Station Ghagwal.

As per details, a party of Police Station Ghagwal headed by SHO Ghagwal during vehicle checking duty at naka
