

# Omar holds pre-budget consultation with public representatives of Jammu Distt

JAMMU: Chief Minister Omar Abdullah on Sunday chaired pre-budget consultations with public representatives from Jammu district at a meeting held at the Civil Secretariat.

The session was attended by Minister Satish Sharma, Chairman District Development Council (DDC), Members Legislative Assembly from District Jammu, Secretary Atal Dulloo. Additional Chief Secretary to the CM Dheeraj Gupta and Principal Secretary Finance Santosh D Vaidva; with some of the MLA's attending the meeting virtually through video conference.

Addressing the participants, Chief Minister Omar Abdullah emphasized the importance of engaging with elected representatives in the budget-making process to ensure that the aspirations and needs of the people are

#### New Delhi railway station stampede: Death toll rises to 18

NEW DELHI: The death toll in the overnight stampede at the packed New Delhi railway station rose to 18 on Sunday, with authorities saying confusion over almost identical train names after an announcement of the platform number for an arriving Prayagraj-bound special train sparked panic

and a sudden rush. The dead included 11 women, two men, one male teen and four children, according to a list put out by the Delhi police. Three people were also grievously injured and 27


POONCH: A brief exchange of fire took place along the Line of Control (LoC) in the Poonch district on Sunday, security officials said.

They said an Indian Army post came under fire from a forested area across the LoC around 11.30 am in Gulpur

They said soldiers retaliated and the exchange of fire lasted for a very brief period. There was no damage on the Indian side, the officials

They said it was not immediately clear whether the Pakistan army was behind the firing, or it was terrorists hiding in the forests and waiting for an opportunity to sneak in.

There were a few cross-border incidents last week, including an IED explosion that killed two army personnel including a captain. Two other soldiers were injured in cross-border firing in violation of ceasefire. Indian troops retaliated befittingly, inflicting "heavy casualties" on the Pakistani side.


