

Skill Development Training on Advanced Techniques in Natural Product and Medicinal Chemistry starts at IIIM Srinagar

SRINAGAR: The skill development program "Hands-on Training on Advanced Techniques in Natural Product and Medicinal Chemistry" commenced on Wednesday at CSIR-IIIM Srinagar (br.) which was inaugurated by Dr. Zabeer Ahmed, Director CSIR-IIIM Jammu virtually.

Dr. Ahmed underscored the pivotal role of natural products and medicinal chemistry in accelerating drug discovery and development while also highlighting recent advances in the field.

Dr Zabeer emphasized the enduring relevance of natural products, stating, "From traditional remedies to modern therapeutics, natural compounds remain a cornerstone of drug discovery. Integrating advanced medicinal chem-

istry techniques with these resources is key to addressing global health challenges."

He further said that the program aims to cultivate a skilled workforce capable of leveraging natural product chemistry for novel therapeutics. By merging traditional knowledge with modern science, it seeks to address pressing healthcare needs through sustainable innovation.

The training combines

theoretical sessions with hands-on labs, focusing on advanced methodologies such as bioactive compound isolation, structural elucidation, and molecular modelling. Participants will gain proficiency in high-throughput screening, spectroscopy, and data analysis tools critical for pharmaceutical research.

20 Attendees from eight states representing academia, industry, and research institutions, reflecting the

program's broad impact, are participating in this training program.

The three-day program is coordinated by Dr Bilal Ahmad Bhat, Principal Scientist and Dr Syed Khalid, Scientist, under the supervision of Er Abdul Rahim, Head IIIM Srinagar (Br.) and Dr Fayaz Malik, Deputy Head. The inaugural session saw participation from other scientists, scholars and technical staff.

Ajatshatru slams Pakistan's Parliament Resolution on Kashmir; calls it desperate ploy to mislead world

Challenges Pakistan to first hold a plebiscite in PoK

JAMMU: Senior BJP leader and former Minister, Ajatshatru Singh has launched a scathing attack on Pakistan's Parliament for passing a resolution urging India to hold a plebiscite in Kashmir, calling it a desperate and hollow attempt to mislead the international community. He asserted that Jammu and Kashmir is an integral part of India and that no external force can alter this undeniable reality. In a press release issued here on Wednesday, Ajatshatru Singh ridiculed Pakistan's move, stating that it exposes the sheer frustration of a failing state that has lost all credibility on the global stage. He said that Pakistan, plagued by political instability, economic collapse, and growing global isolation, is

attempting to divert attention from its own failures by reviving baseless rhetoric on Kashmir. He questioned Pakistan's moral standing, pointing out its brutal suppression of minorities, enforced disappearances in Balochistan, and its active sponsorship of terrorism.

Lambasting Pakistan for its continued interference in India's internal affairs, the senior BJP leader reminded the world that the people of Jammu and Kashmir have repeatedly rejected Pakistan's nefarious designs.

He asserted that the Union Territory is on a path of unprecedented development under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, leaving behind the dark shadows of separatism and violence.

He challenged Pakistan to

first hold a plebiscite in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK), where people have been suffering under oppressive rule, denied even basic rights.

Ajatshatru further urged the global community to recognize Pakistan's role in fueling terrorism and instability in the region. He stressed that Pakistan must first dismantle terror networks operating on its soil, bring to justice those responsible for the 26/11 Mumbai attacks, and ensure the safety of its own citizens before making laughable demands on Kashmir.

Slamming Pakistan's continued propaganda, he reaffirmed that the future of Jammu and Kashmir lies solely with India, and no amount of false narratives or resolutions can change that unshakable truth.

Several detained as police thwart protest march by daily wagers

JAMMU: Nearly a dozen protesters were taken into preventive custody after a group of daily wagers tried to take out a protest march in support of their demands here on Wednesday, officials said. All J&K Daily Wagers Sangharsh Samiti announced the march from Maulana Azad Stadium to Civil Secretariat to press for implementation of minimum wages act and regularization of their services, they said. The protesters, including a group of Asha workers, assembled on the main road outside the stadium and

staged a protest. As they tried to march towards the Civil Secretariat, police detained 10 of the protesters and dispersed the rest including women. "We planned the protest rally to invite the attention of the government towards our long pending demands for regularization and implementation of minimum wages act ahead of the upcoming budget session," chairman of the samiti Sunny Kant Chib told reporters here. He said they have been rendering their services in different departments for the past three decades and want the government to provide them "justice".
